OUR MANDATE: RESEARCH & CONSERVATION.

MPCP is a scientific and education initiative. We monitor populations and promote long-term coexistence, **NOT RESCUE OR LAW ENFORCEMENT.**



JURISDICTION LIES WITH GOVERNMENT AUTHORITIES.

Management, veterinary intervention, rescue, and law enforcement are under the Kenya Wildlife Service (KWS) and Narok County Government. We are **NOT** an animal welfare group or law enforcement.



WE WORK IN PARTNERSHIP.

In incidents, we act as **FIRST RESPONDERS**, providing information and notifying KWS, KWS makes the final decision. We support their response efforts.
