### **Is the parking free of charge?**

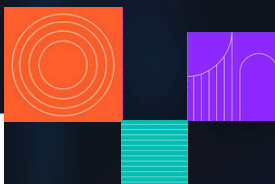
At the venue the parking is NOT free of charge, however the parking of Auchan is only a 2 minute walk and free.

### **Can I stay overnight?**
