

Is ASE Remote Testing Right For You?

STEP 1

You must create a secure environment within your home or workplace to take an ASE test online. Remote testing is only available for recertification tests.

STEP 4

You have a room with solid walls and doors, well-lit, and free from clutter, background noise, and disruptions. It is not a classroom, closet, restroom, or open concept.

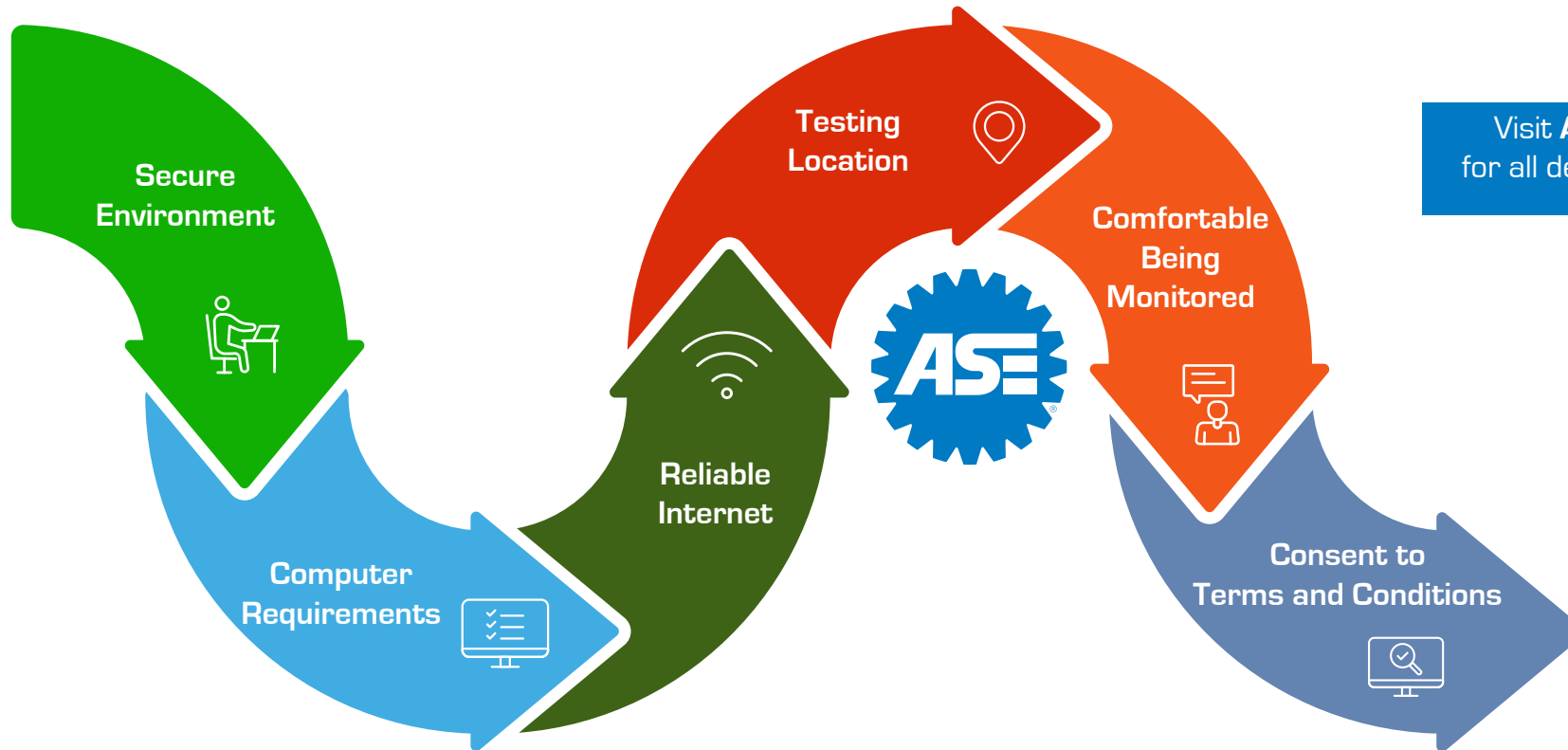
STEP 5

You understand that real-time audio and video monitoring takes place throughout the remote testing process, and are comfortable being monitored.

START HERE

You must pass all 6 steps to be eligible for remote ASE testing.

STEP 2

You have a movable web camera, working speakers and microphone. The ProProctor application is download and installed. My computer passed the system readiness check and meets requirements.

STEP 3

You have a strong signal with an internet speed of 5.0 Mbps or greater. There is no VPN or firewalls to block the application.

STEP 6

You understand that remote testing requires a secure environment within your home or workplace to take an ASE test online, and you will follow all terms and conditions to avoid a violation.
