SELF REGISTRATION

- Register by 5:00 PM Friday, February 20, 2026 to receive the discounted rate.
- Annual School students must use the online registration system.

- Many classes fill early. Last day to register and pay for Spring School: Sunday, March 1, 2026 from 8 AM to Noon.

If your class has prerequisites, there are additional steps to the registration process.

- Proof of prerequisites is required to be provided within 48 hours of registration by uploading in the student portal.

If you don't want to test for Pro Board certification, simply reply to the certification office when they contact you for proof of prerequisites.

NOTICE: Once registration / tuition payment has been made, **you will not be able to change method of payment.** The original form of payment, such as a personal credit card, cannot be changed.

CANCELLATION / TRANSFERS

TEEX has implemented a \$50 non-refundable administrative fee for customers requiring special handling on registration changes such as class transfers. This fee is not reimbursable by the Forest Service.
