Overview

With the early access launch of Fire Alarm Monitoring, we invite Verkada partners to join our new Qualified Fire Partner (QFP) Program. Once approved, you will be eligible to install and service Verkada Fire Alarms on the BP52 combo intrusion/fire panel

The QFP Program verifies that you have the licensing, certification, and technical capability to deploy and maintain code-compliant fire alarm systems, including:

- Designing systems in accordance with NFPA 72 and local AHJ requirements
- Installing and commissioning fire alarm devices and panels
- Testing, inspecting, and documenting system performance

How to become a QFP

To become a QFP, you will need to submit an application along with the following documents on the [Verkada Partner Portal](#):

- Proof of an active state/local fire alarm contractor license (or equivalent for relevant authority having jurisdiction)
- At least one technician on staff holding an active NICET Level II (or higher) certification in Fire Alarm Systems, verified directly through NICET
- References or sample documentation from recently completed fire alarm jobs
- Your legal decision maker will also need to sign a partner addendum

Once your application is accepted, you will be able to order fire monitoring licenses and enable fire monitoring on Verkada Alarm systems.

- **Access Verkada fire alarm monitoring opportunities**
Only QFPs can sell, install, and service Verkada's fire alarm systems.
- **Win intrusion/fire takeover opportunities**
Many existing systems are combo intrusion and fire installs. As a QFP, you will be able to offer a complete Verkada takeover solution.

How to get certified equipment

Only approved Qualified Fire Partners are able to order Verkada Fire Monitoring Licenses. A valid fire monitoring license is required to enable fire on the BP52 alarm panel. UL-listed*, fire-ready BP52 panels will be added to orders with a fire monitoring license.

Requesting early access equipment

The UL-listed*, fire-ready version of the BP52 is currently offered through an early access program. During this phase, panels and equipment are not available through standard ordering channels.

- Existing BP52 units in the field are not fire-ready. Please work with your Verkada representative to arrange a panel swap if adding fire to an existing system.
- During the early access phase, please flag fire-ready installs to your Verkada representative to ensure the correct equipment ships.
