Women seem to have the upper hand when it comes to completing their tertiary education




Ratio of female to male students in tertiary level education: Gender Parity Index in Education

But there are still loads more men than women in the workforce, across the world.




Ratio of female to male labor force participation rate (%) (modeled ILO estimate)
