Classification must be aligned according to the tasks, knowledge, skills and abilities outlined on the CCPT with the appropriate classification level pursuant to the IT Classifications Allocation Guide and Job Descriptions published by CalHR.

The Cyber Career Pathways Tool presents an interactive way to explore the updated Work Rules within the NICE framework². The tool depicts the cyber workforces according to distinct, yet complementary skill communities. It also highlights core attributes among each of the Work Rules and offers actionable insights for employers, professionals, and those considering a career in cybersecurity.
