
USING ONE PHOTO IN MULTIPLE FRAMES

USING 1 PHOTO IN MULTIPLE FRAMES

Perusing through the gallery this past week, I noticed that there is a technique that not many of our members use on a regular basis. So, I'm pointing it out, because I think it's a fabulous way to show off our photos... using 1 photo in multiple frames. This is a really good way to bring the focus to our photos.

Here are some pretty examples from ChaosLounge & Weaselwatchr:



It's such a simple technique, and can have such a good impact, I'm not sure why we don't use it more often!

Any kind of frame can be used. For this photo...




...I'm just using a simple frame shape that is included in Photoshop to bring focus to the main part of the photo:






Then add another shape to highlight another part of the photo:



And one more:



Once you have your frames placed on your photo, create fill boxes for each one:





Then make duplicates of the photo and clip a copy to each of the boxes:



Now the page is ready to be scrapped! SO EASY! You can add as many frames as you want:



Here are some more quick examples – and I just used a stroke & shadow style for frames on these, but, again, you can do this with any kind of framing!








A full page photo, highlight part of it with a frame and add a framed second photo:



Frame within a frame:




This one I diddled with a little bit to make it look like he's holding a framed target:






Layering framed photos, as in the example layout by Chaos Lounge above, is an easy thing to do as well:



The key thing to remember here is to move the template boxes, not the photo



If you move a photo, the effect is lost:






Moving the boxes instead, you can position them the way you want on the page without losing the effect it has:



And if you don't feel like you have enough of the photo showing, you can duplicate a box/clipped photo, then move the box to show more photo:



How easy is that? Give it a try and show us your results! Happy Scrapping!
