

Abbreviations:

R=ring

CH=chain

"-"=picot

"+"=join

rw=reverse work

p=picot(according to pattern stated)

clr=close ring

Center Ring

R: 3-3-3-3-3-3-1, clr. Tie and work in ends.

Row#1

R: 5+(to p of center R)5, clr, do not rw

CH: 5, rw

R: 5-5, clr, rw

CH: 5-5, rw

R: 5-5, clr, do not rw

CH: 5, rw

R: 5+(to next p of center R)5, clr, do not rw

Continue around the center ring with R and CH combination. Tie and work in ends.

Row#2

Join ball and shuttle threads to picot of outer ring of Row#1

CH: 4-4+(to p of next ring in Row#1)

Repeat chain all around and join to first chain made. Tie and work in ends.

Row#3

CH: 5+(to p of ch of Row#2)-5+(where ch of Row#2 was fastened)

Repeat around. Tie and work in ends.

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
