

Abbreviations:

R=ring

CH=chain

"-"=picot

"+"=join

rw=reverse work

p=picot(according to pattern stated)

clr=close ring

Center Ring

R: 3-3-3-3-3-3-1, clr. Tie and work in

ends.

Row#1

\*R: 6+(to p of center R)6, clr, rw

CH: 6-6+(to next p of center R)

CH: 6-6, rw\*

Repeat from \* to \* all around joining to last

CH at base of 1st R

Row#2

\*R: 4-5+(to p on first CH in Row#1)5-4, clr, rw

CH: 6-6, rw

R: 4+(to last p of prev R)5+(to p of next CH in Row#1)5-4, clr, rw

CH: 6-6, rw

R: 4+(to last p of prev R)7+(where the 2 CH of Row#1 meet)7-4, clr, rw

CH: 6-6, rw\*

Repeat from \* to \* all around in the same way. Join last CH at base of 1st R.

Tie and work in ends.
