

Abbreviations:

R=ring

CH=chain

"-"=picot

"+"=join

rw=reverse work

p=picot(according to pattern stated)

clr=close ring

R: 5-2-2-2-2-5, clr

*R: 5+(to last p of prev R)2-2-2-2-2-2-5,

clr

R: 5+(to last p of prev R)2-2-2-2-5, clr, rw

CH: 10-10, rw

R: 5-2-2+(to 5th p of last R made)2-2-2-5,

clr *

Repeat around from * to *, joining last R to 1st, and last CH at base of 1st R. Tie and

work in ends.

Row#2

Join ball and shuttle threads to middle picot of 2nd ring of cloverleaf.

*R: 3-2-2-2-3, clr, do not rw

CH: 3-2-2-3+(skip two p of R and join to next p)

CH: 3-2-2-2-3+(to middle picot of both of nest two Rs together)

CH: 3-2-2-2-3+(to 2nd p of next R)

CH: 3-2-2-3+(to middle p of same R)*

Repeat from * to * around, joining last CH at base of 1st R. Tie and work in ends. Tie the picots of the 4 long CHs together with a firm buttonhole-knot, at center.
