

Abbreviations:

R=ring

CH=chain

"-"=picot

"+"=join

rw=reverse work

p=picot(according to pattern stated)

clr=close ring

Row#1(outside row)

R: 6-6, clr, leave 1/4 inch space of thread, rw

R: 5-2-2-2-2-5, clr

R: 5+(to last p of prev large R)2-2-2-2-5, clr

R: 5+(to last p of prev large R)2-2-2-2-2-5,

clr, leave 1/4 inch space of thread, rw

R: 6+(to p of first small R)6, clr, leave 1/4 inch space of thread, rw

R: 5+(to last p of prev large R)2-2-2-2-2-5,

clr, leave 1/4 inch space of thread, rw

R: 6-6, clr, leave 1/4 inch space of thread, rw

R: 5+(to last p of prev large R)2-2-2-2-5, clr, leave 1/4 inch space of thread, rw This completes one corner and side. Repeat with a small ring and another cloverleaf and continue around. Join last large R to first large R by the first and last picots. Tie at base of first small ring.

## Row#2

Join ball and shuttle threads to picot which joins the 2 small rings at corner.

CH: 6-6+(to p of single small R)

CH: 6-6+(to p which connects next 2 small R)

Repeat around, joining last CH where 1st started.

## Row#3(center ring)

R: 3+(to p of CH next to the corner)2+(to p of next CH)5+(to p of next CH)2+(to p of next CH)5+(to p of next CH)2+(to p of next CH)5+(to p of next CH)2+(to p of next CH)2, clr.

Tie and work in ends.
