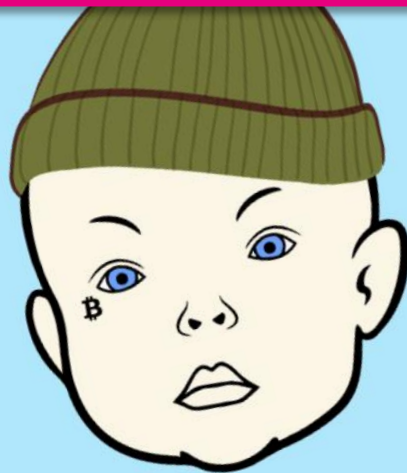

# Introduction

What is MetaMask?

What else do we need to know,

MetaMask is one of the most trusted multi-chain compatible wallets. If you haven't installed a MetaMask wallet in your browser yet, please do so. Otherwise this will not work. For demonstration purposes, we chose the MetaMask wallet and Google Chrome as our browser. Please take note, that it is possible to operate MetaMask in other browsers as well (such as the Brave Browser).

Therefore, simply go to <https://metamask.io/> and download the browser extension and create your wallet. You will be guided through the whole process. Also, there are many YouTube videos explaining, how you can successfully install your MetaMask wallet and how to use it properly. Furthermore, you can install MetaMask on your mobile phone. The big advantage of the mobile version of MetaMask is simply, that you can use it on the go and also view your NFTs by importing them. This is not possible in the MetaMask browser extension yet at the time of writing (23.01.2022).

Make sure, to download it from <https://metamask.io/> only! Unfortunately, scammers do not shy away of creating fake MetaMask apps – be cautious. If you want to know, how to import NFTs into your mobile MetaMask wallet, make sure to follow this guide:

Also, the wallet and trading account used to buy MATIC transfer it to our MetaMask wallet shown in this guide, is KuCoin. It does not matter, how you get MATIC into your MetaMask wallet. You can choose a variety of wallets and providers to buy and transfer MATIC. Further options would be Binance, Kraken, Coinbase or any such like. The principles for successfully completing transactions always stay the same:

Always make sure, to use the proper network. In some cases, wallets detect the right network and choose it for the transaction. For MATIC, it has to be the Polygon Chain.

Enter the right recipient's address (in our case, this will be the public address of your MetaMask wallet). You can do so, by simply copying the public address. This can be done by simply clicking on your public address. After clicking on it, it should say „copied to clipboard“ and you can now simply enter the address by pasting it into the receiving address field.

Further make sure to have enough MATIC in your wallet, to also cover the gas fees (transaction fees). Due to Polygon being a rather cheap Chain, when it comes to gas fees, you usually do not have to pay more gas fees than a few USD or even just a few cents. The gas fees can fluctuate, due to them being dependent on the current network traffic.

Before you transfer the whole amount of any currency, please make a test transaction, simply to make sure that everything works just fine. If there were any problems (e.g. if you chose the wrong network to process the transaction), you would lose a few cents, but not the whole amount of coins/tokens.

Also make sure to set the gas limits high enough. Otherwise, your transaction might not be processed, which would result in a failed transaction, which you'd have to cancel – which also costs some cents. Usually, the gas limit for each transaction is set high enough by default.

If you spot any orange fields in this manual – they simply hide my wallet address. You never know, what's going on in people's minds. But don't let them bother you in any way. You will be guided by red frames, which we put in to highlight the most important things.

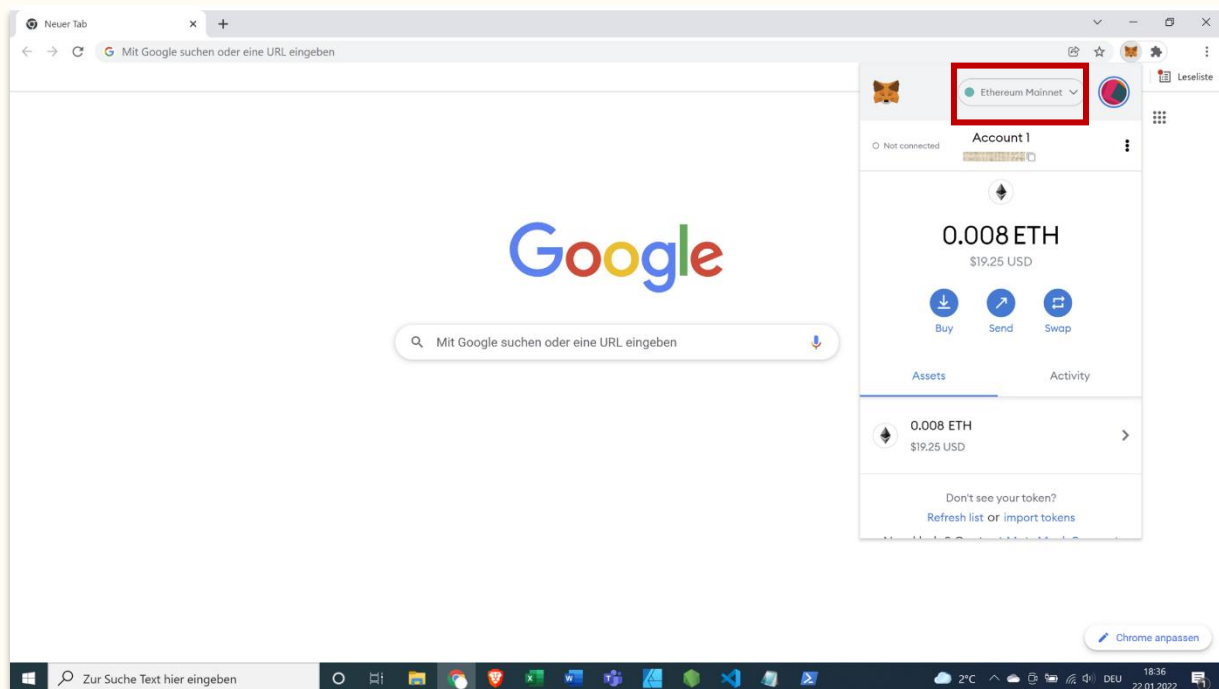

## Connect to the Polygon Chain

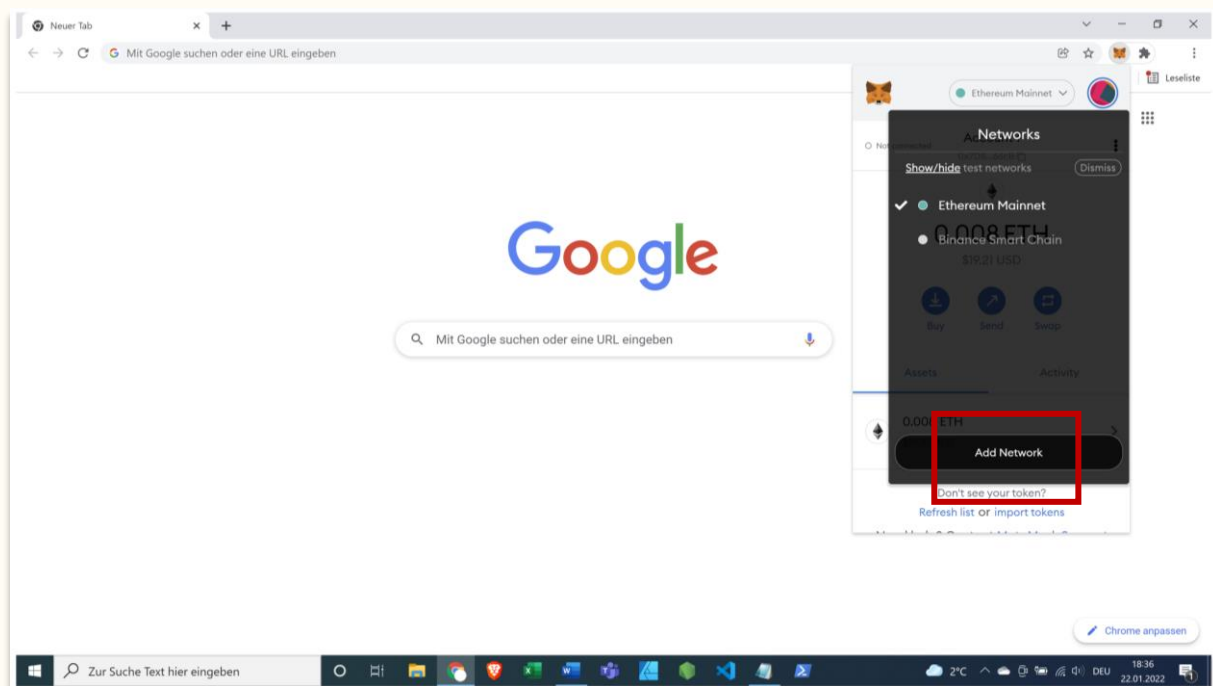


With this said, let's jump right into it!

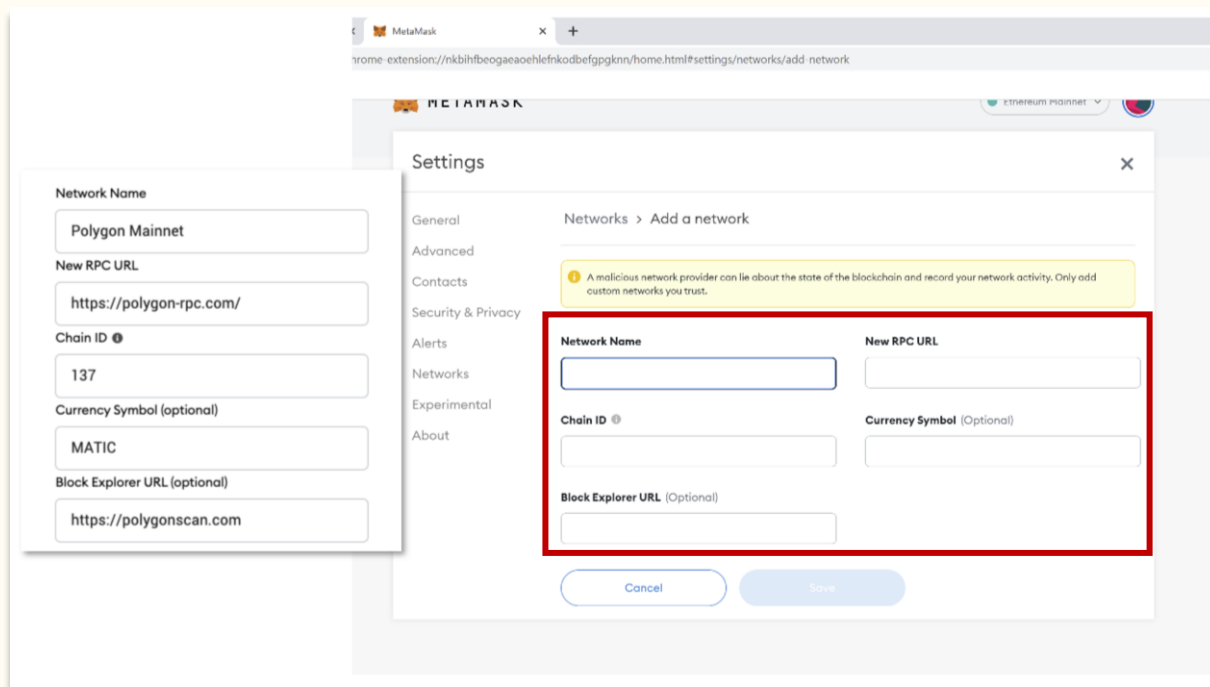
First of all, we have to connect your MetaMask wallet to the Polygon Chain. Therefore, open your MetaMask wallet and click on the field which says „Ethereum Mainnet“ by default. This leads you directly to the list of available and connected networks.



Now, go ahead and click the „add network“ field, to add a connection to the Polygon Chain.

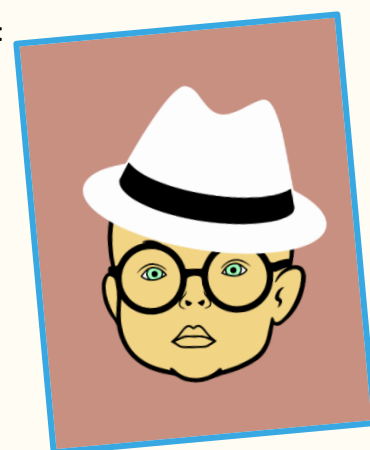


Now the network menu opens. To add a new network, you have to fill out the fields „Network Name“, „New RPC URL“, „Chain ID“, „Currency Symbol“ and „Block Explorer URL“.



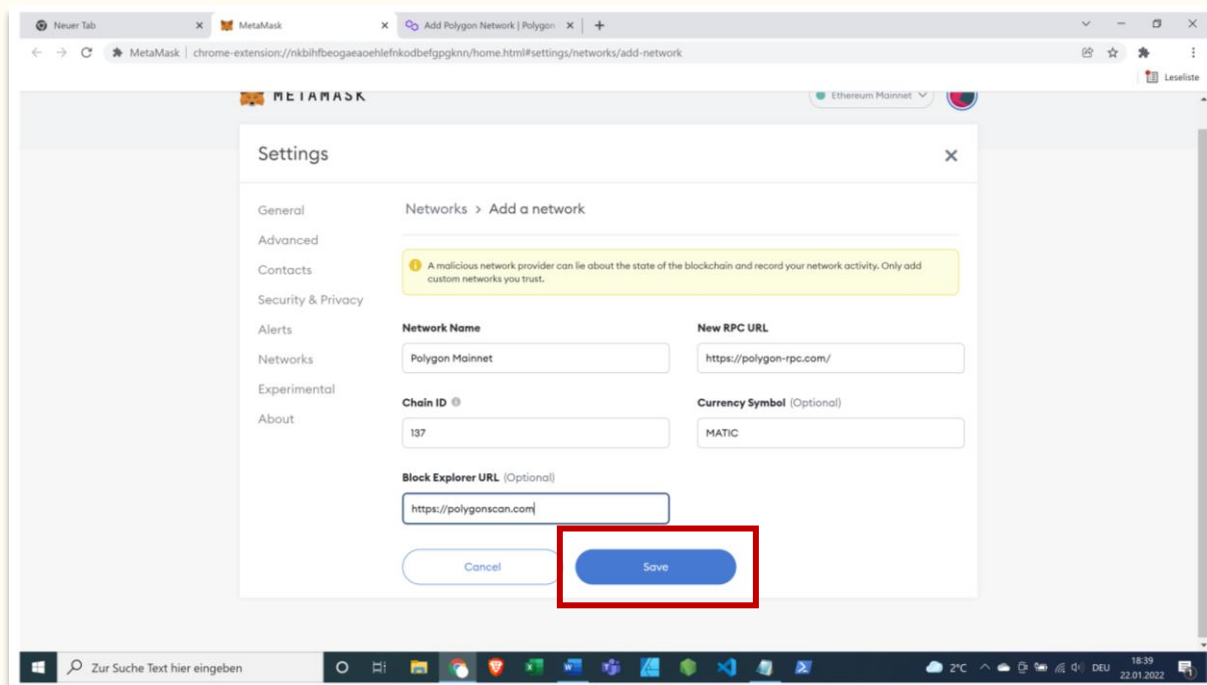
To fill in the right information, please use the information provided as follows\*:

**Network Name:** Polygon Mainnet  
**New RPC URL:** <https://polygon-rpc.com/>  
**Chain ID:** 137  
**Currency Symbol:** MATIC  
**Block Explorer:** <https://polygonscan.com>

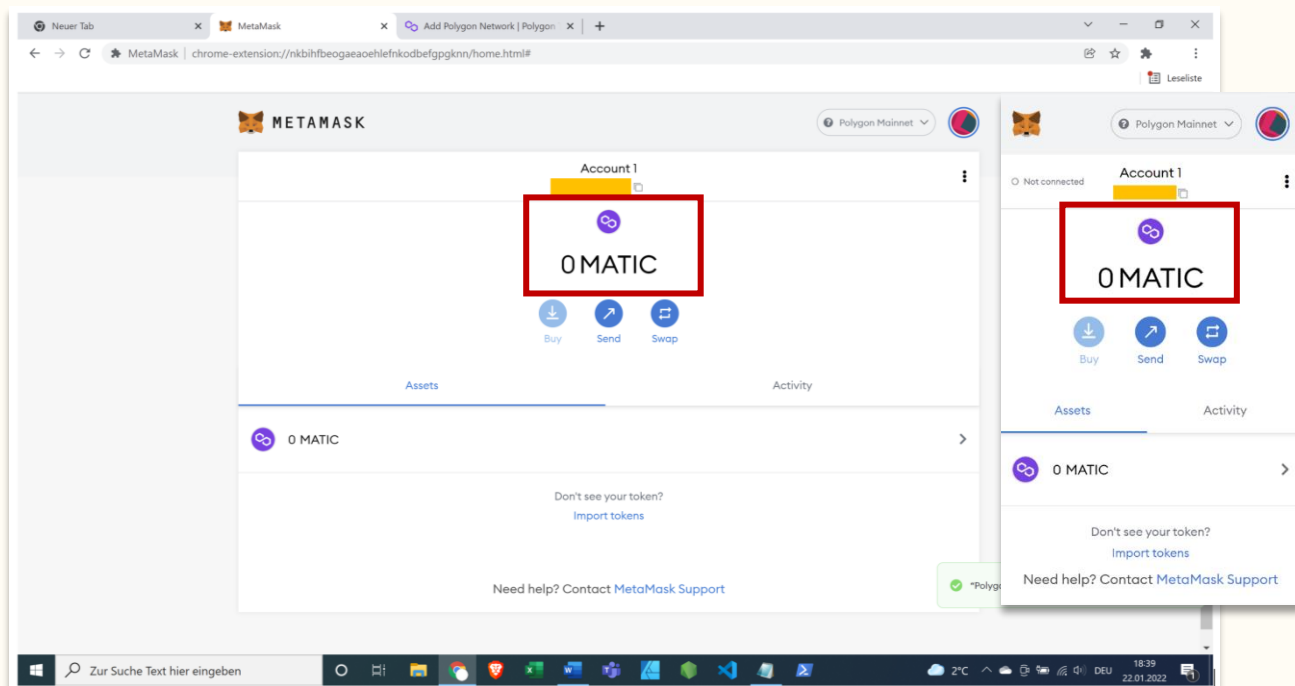


\*Please make sure, that the input-information is **up to date**. It is possible, that the information you have to enter changes over time. A quick google-research should do it.

Now, having filled in the needed information, click the blue „save“ button, et voilà – you are now connected to the Polygon Chain.



Such as „ETH“ is the native currency of the Ethereum Network, the native currency of the Polygon Chain is „MATIC“. Therefore, your wallet will show you the amount of MATIC you currently hold (in this case it says 0). Here you can see the display on the MetaMask website as well as in your wallet.

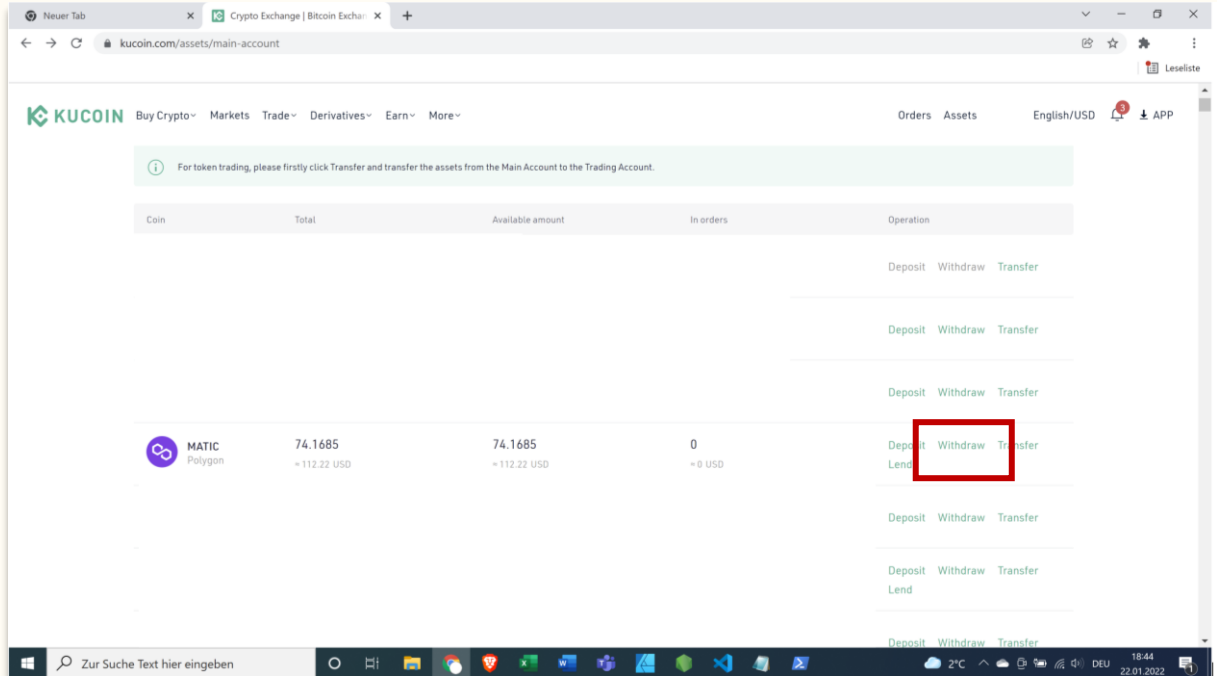

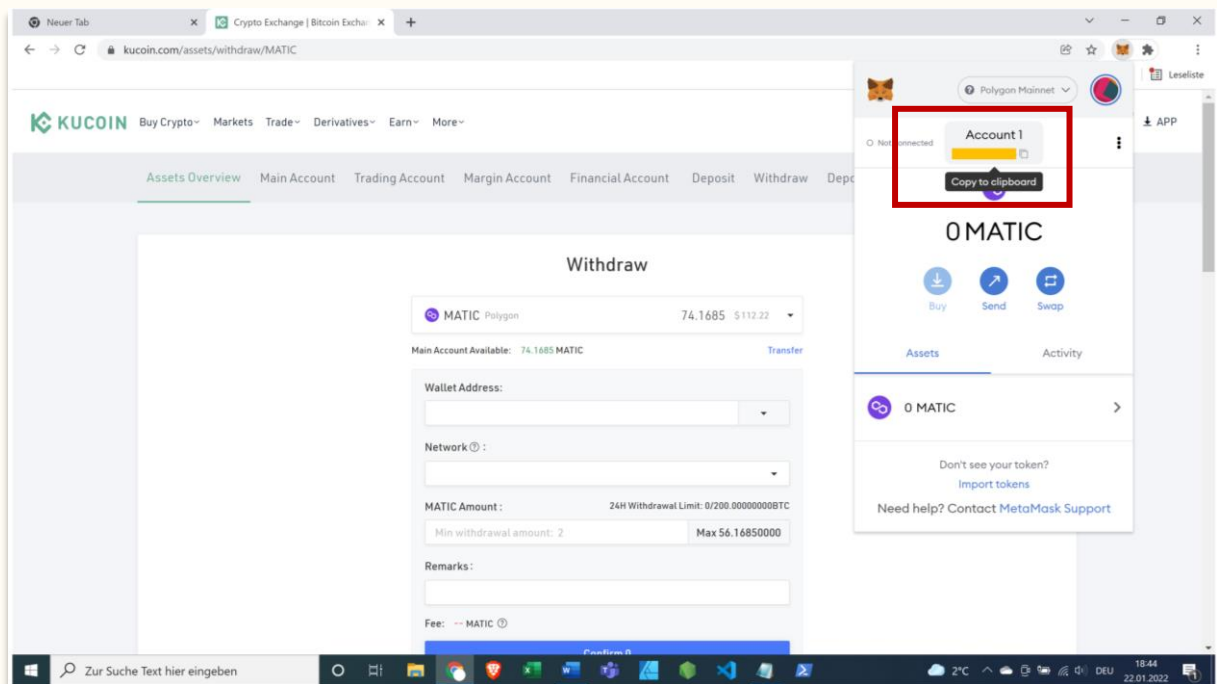

Now, go to the wallet / crypto account of your choice. As mentioned earlier, we used KuCoin for this demonstration. As you can see, we already successfully bought some MATIC. On the right hand side of the line concerning MATIC, you can find the buttons „deposit“, „withdraw“, „transfer“ and „lend“. To withdraw MATIC to our MetaMask wallet, we now click „withdraw“.

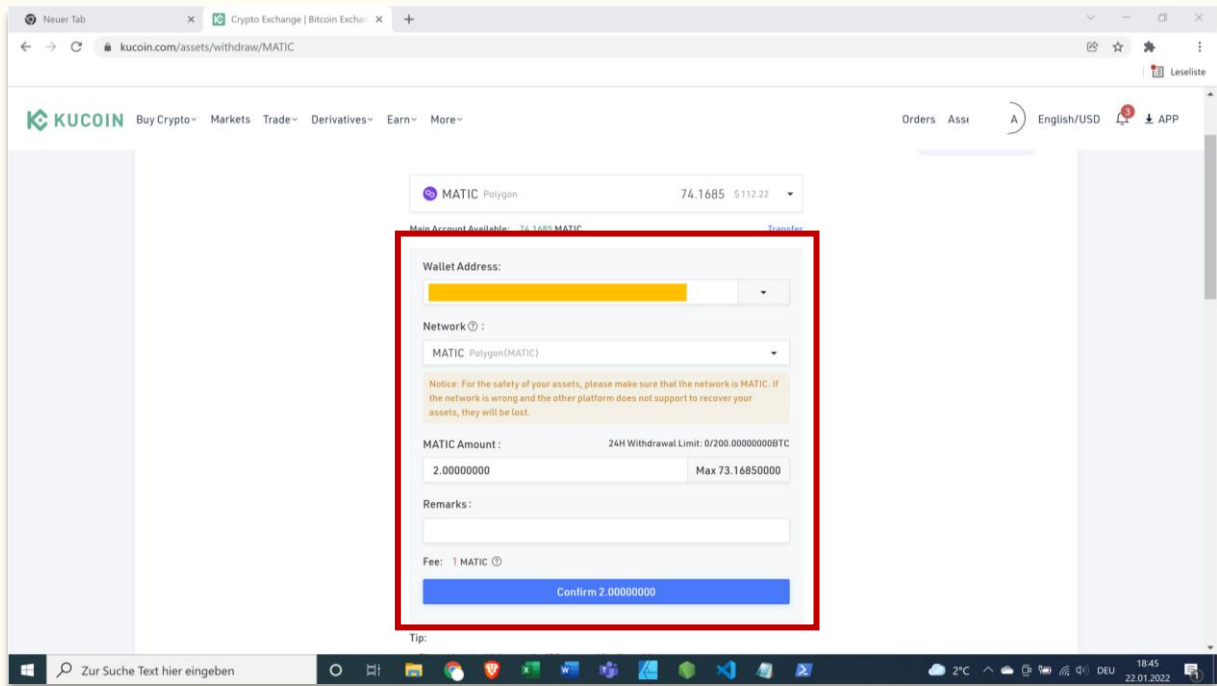


As you can see, the withdrawal-menu pops up. Now you have to enter the right wallet address. Simply open your MetaMask extension (in Chrome by clicking on the puzzle symbol and choosing MetaMask) and click on your wallet address. This automatically copies your wallet address to your clipboard. In this picture, the wallet address is covered by an orange field, due to privacy reasons.

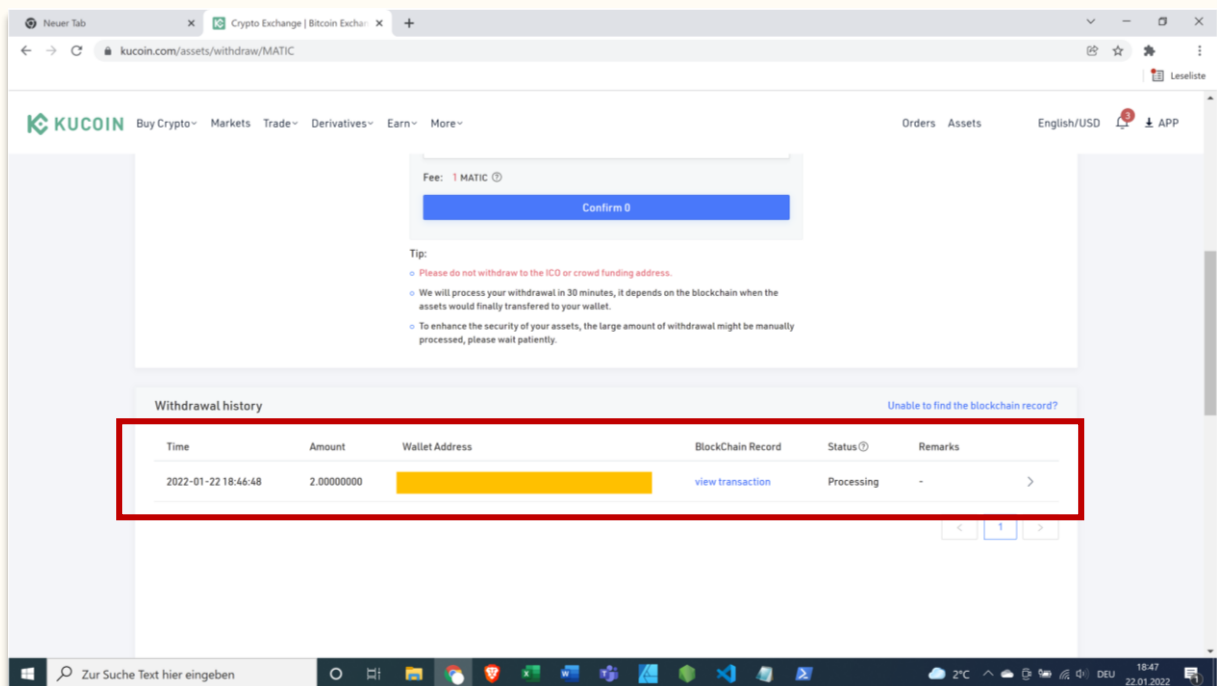


Now you simply paste the copied address into the field which says „wallet address“ and choose the MATIC network. This is very important, otherwise you could lose your funds.

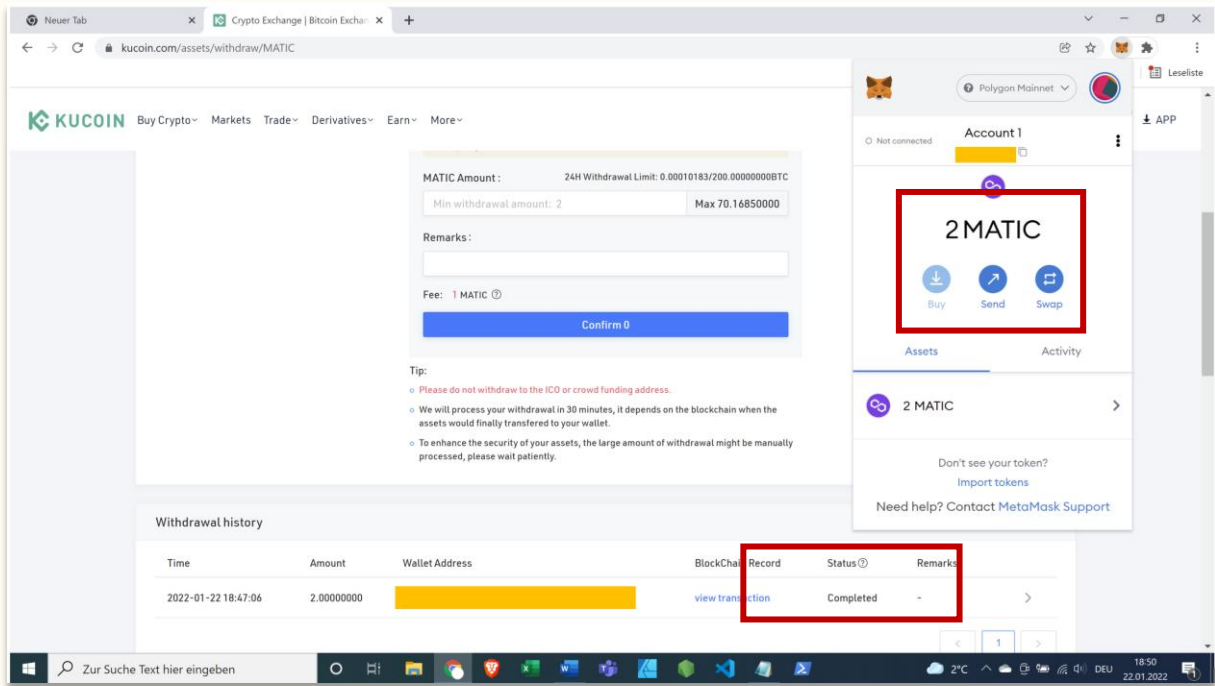
Before you send over the whole amount of MATIC, make a test transaction like we did here with only 2 MATIC, to make sure that everything works. To confirm the transaction, click on „confirm“. Now the transaction is sent off into the vast space of the Polygon Chain and will be processed shortly.



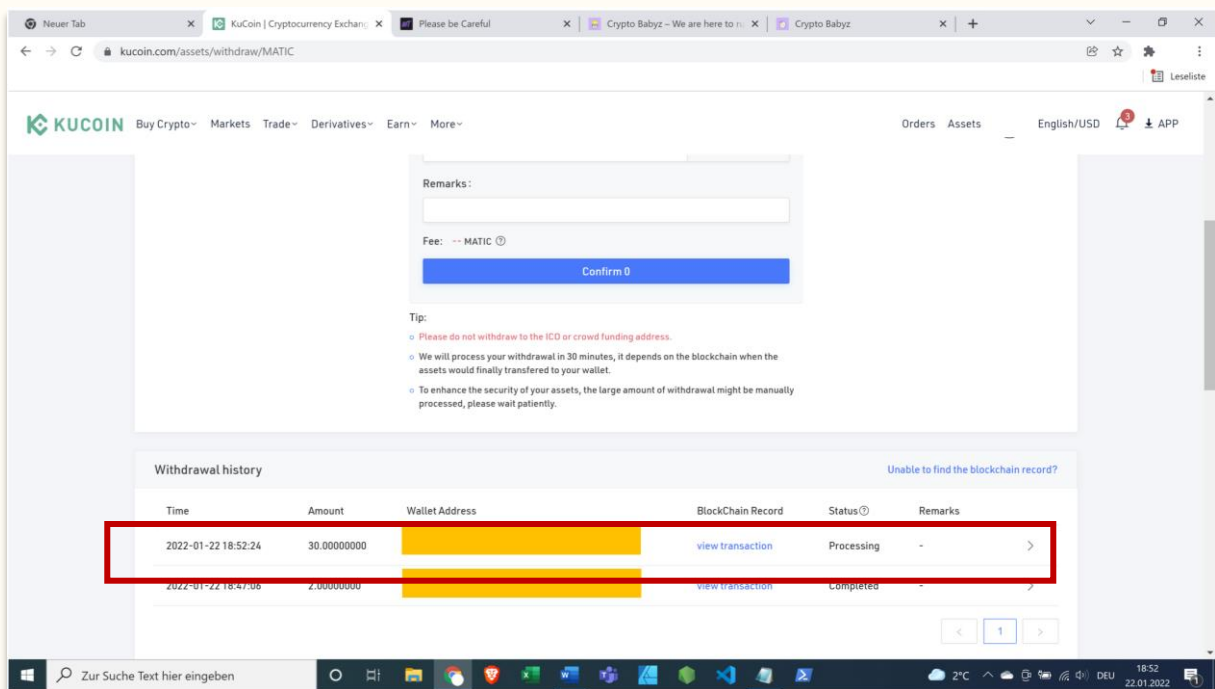
Beneath the withdrawal menu you can see the withdrawal history. After confirming the transaction as explained above, you can find the status of your transaction here. Here it says „processing“, which means, that it might take up to a few minutes, until your transaction was successful.



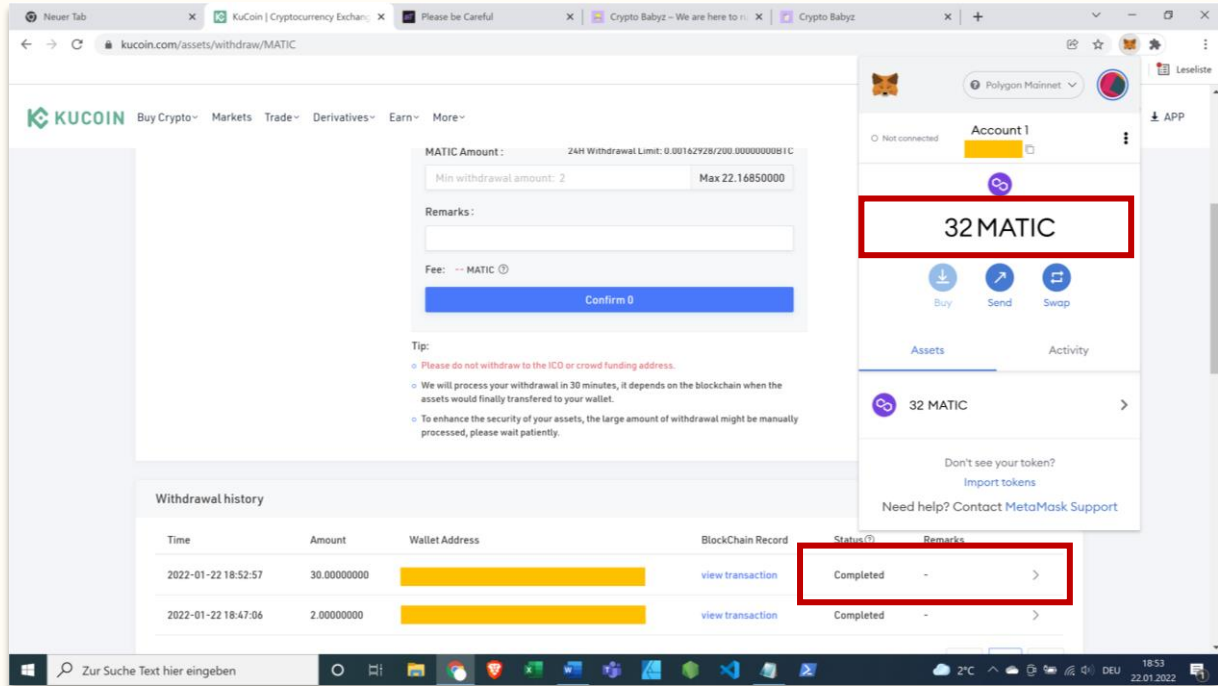
Here on the second picture, the transaction status now changed to „completed“. Also you can see on the right hand side, that now there are 2 MATIC in the MetaMask wallet. This means, that the transaction was successful. Oh yeah, baby!



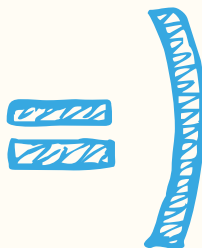
After making sure that we did everything properly and that the transaction works as planned, we now send over the remaining MATIC. To leave no logical gaps in this manual, we put screenshots of us completing the second transaction.



As you can see on the next picture, the status of the second transaction says „completed“. now there are 32 MATIC in our MetaMask wallet and we have more than enough MATIC to get us a Crypto Baby (one baby costs 25 MATIC) and cover all the transaction fees.

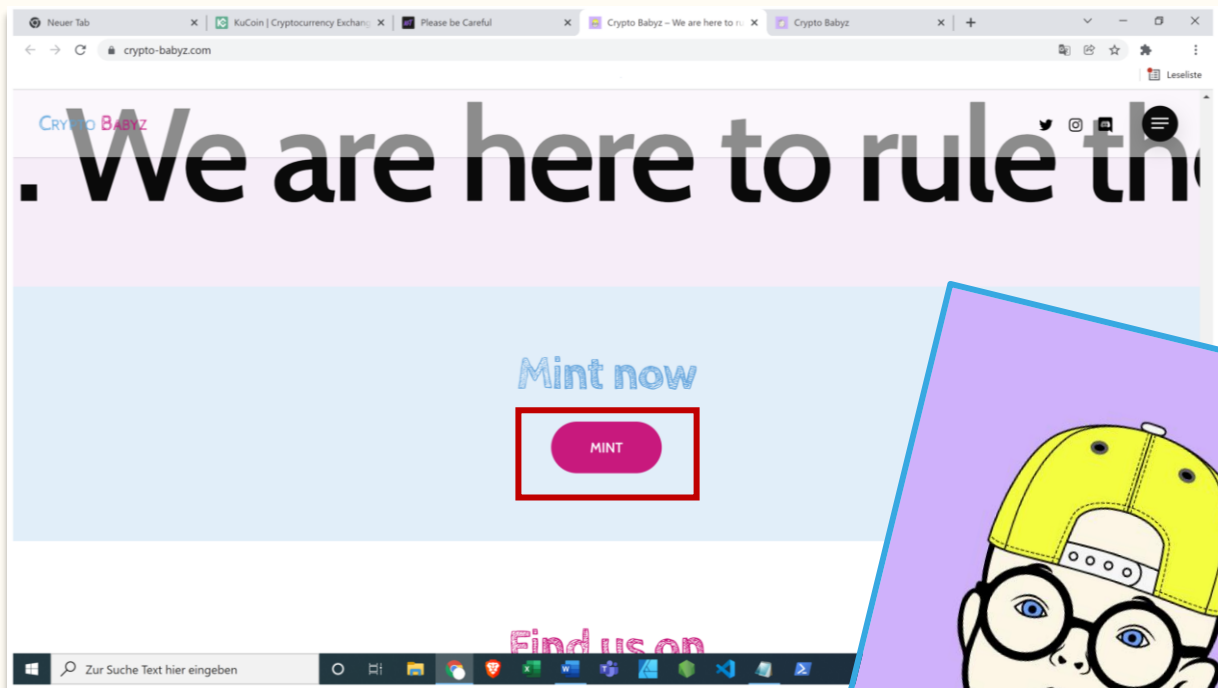

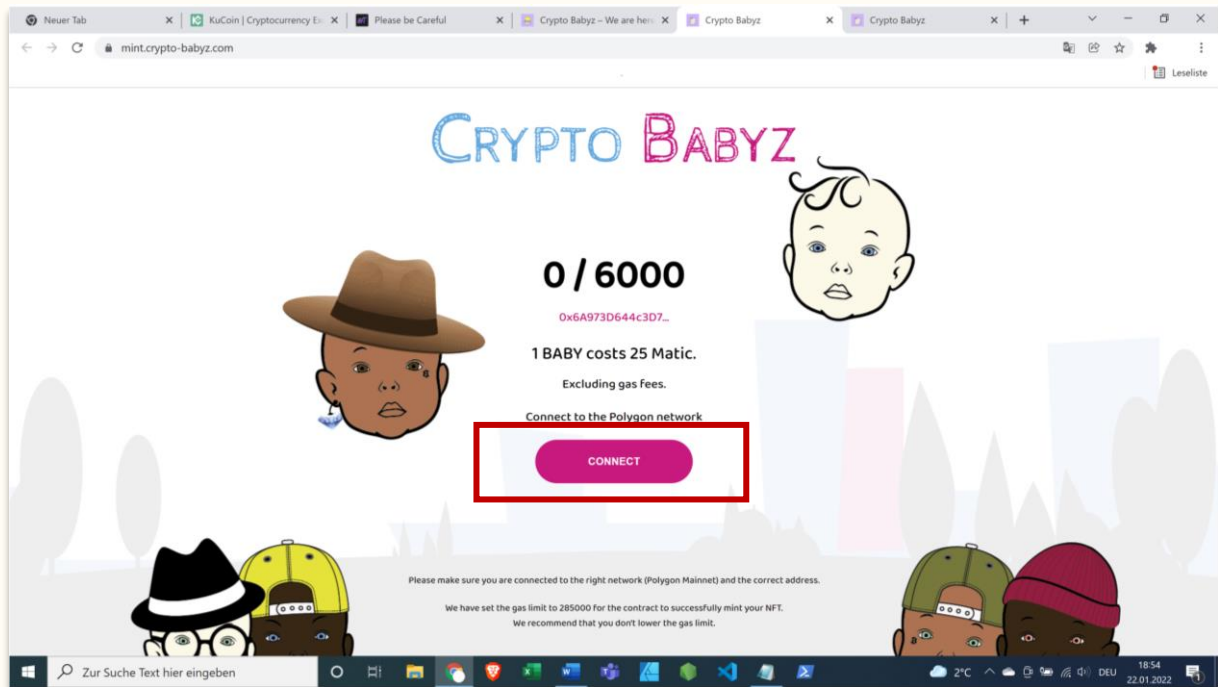


That's why we head over to [www.crypto-babyz.com](http://www.crypto-babyz.com) and keep scrolling down, until we have reached the „mint“ button, as seen in the following picture.

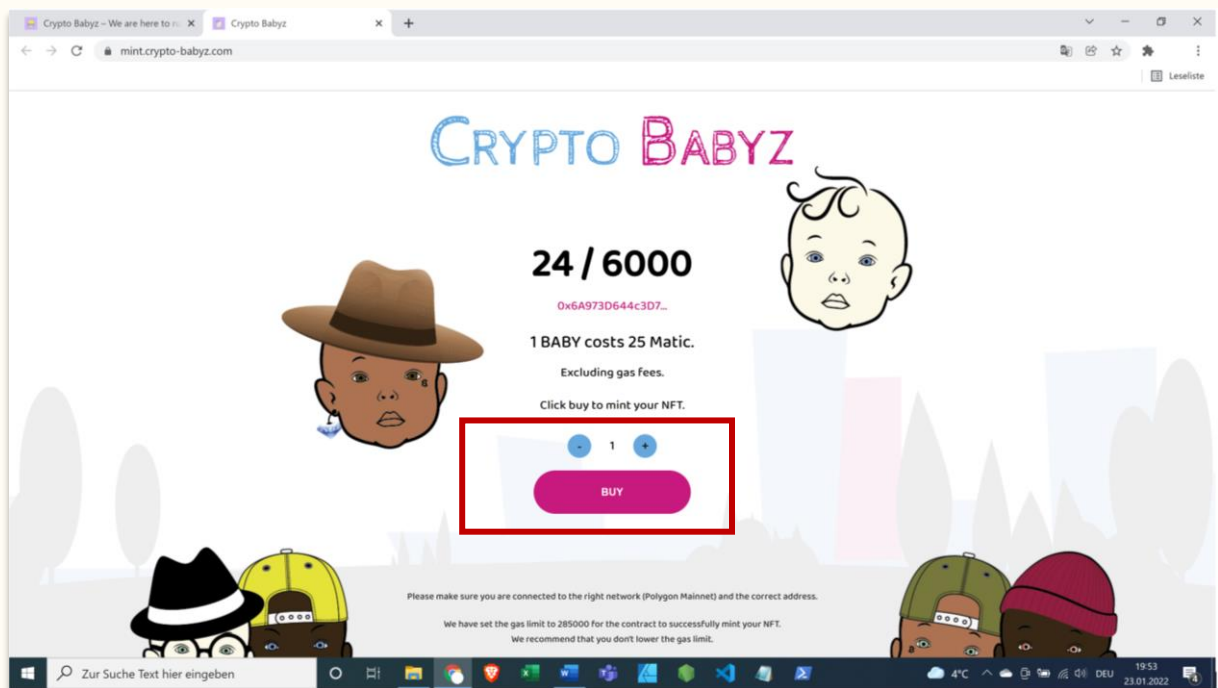




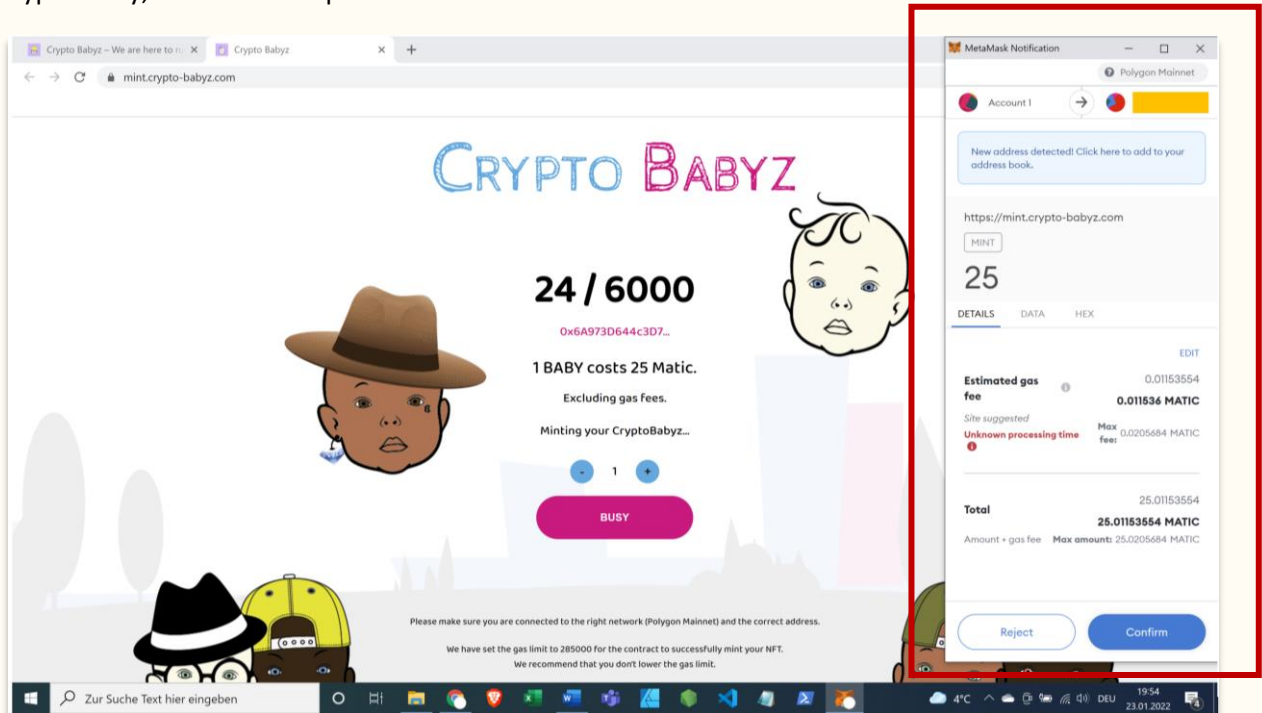
This will send you over to this site, as seen on the picture. Click the „connect“ button.



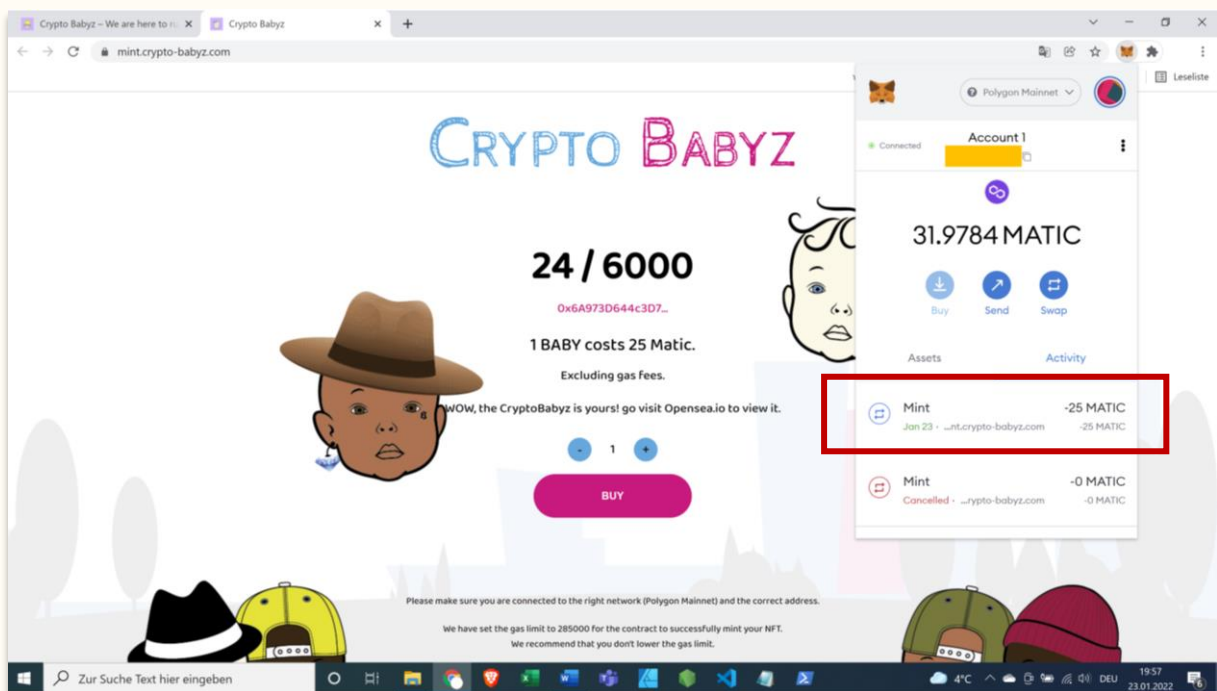
Now you are able to see how many babies have already been minted and select, how many you would like to mint. By the way: „minting“ describes the process of buying the NFT and putting in on the blockchain in the same move, essentially. If you chose the amount of babies you want to mint, click „buy“.



This will send a request to your MetaMask wallet, where you have to confirm the transaction after quickly checking the gas fees and so on. Usually, the gas fees are very low on the Polygon Chain. If it says „unknown processing time“ like on the first picture, you can set the gas limit a little higher, by clicking „edit“. Then it should change to something like „> 30 sec.“. By the way, 0.011 MATIC are the equivalent of less than 2 cents. That was the height of the transaction’s cost at the time of minting our Crypto Baby, as seen in the picture.



In your MetaMask wallet you can see your transaction history by viewing „activity“. You can see, that the last transaction was a successful mint, which cost 25 MATIC. This was the mint of our Crypto Baby.

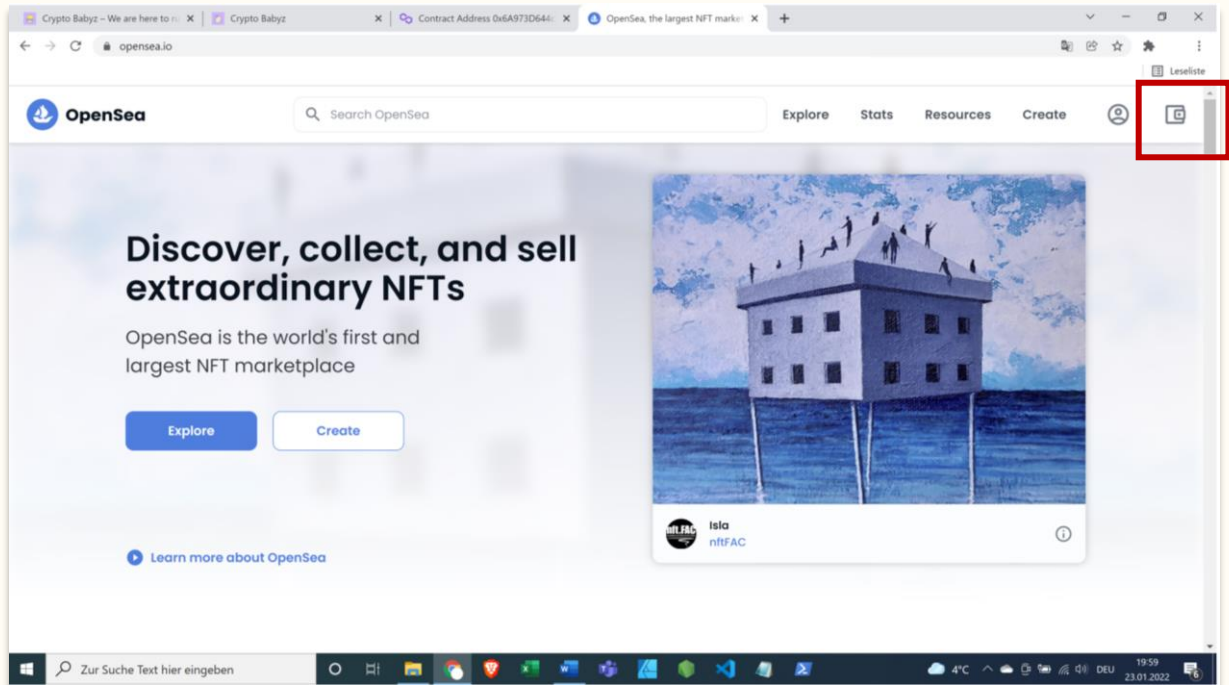


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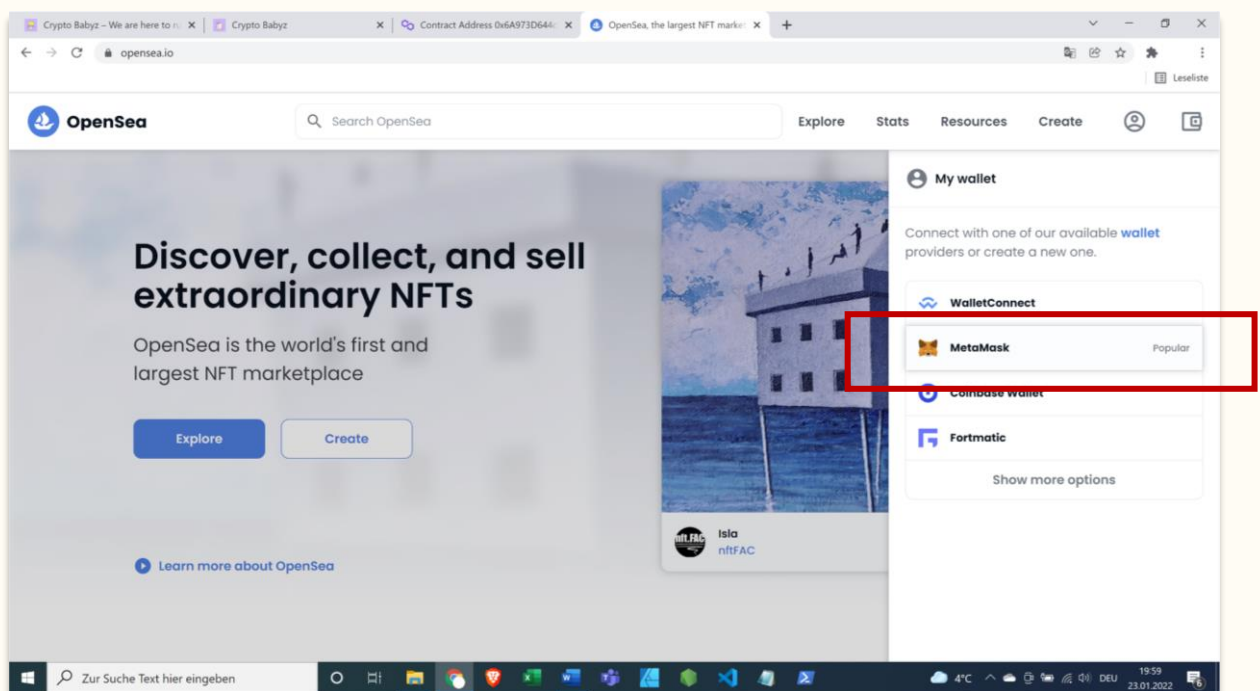

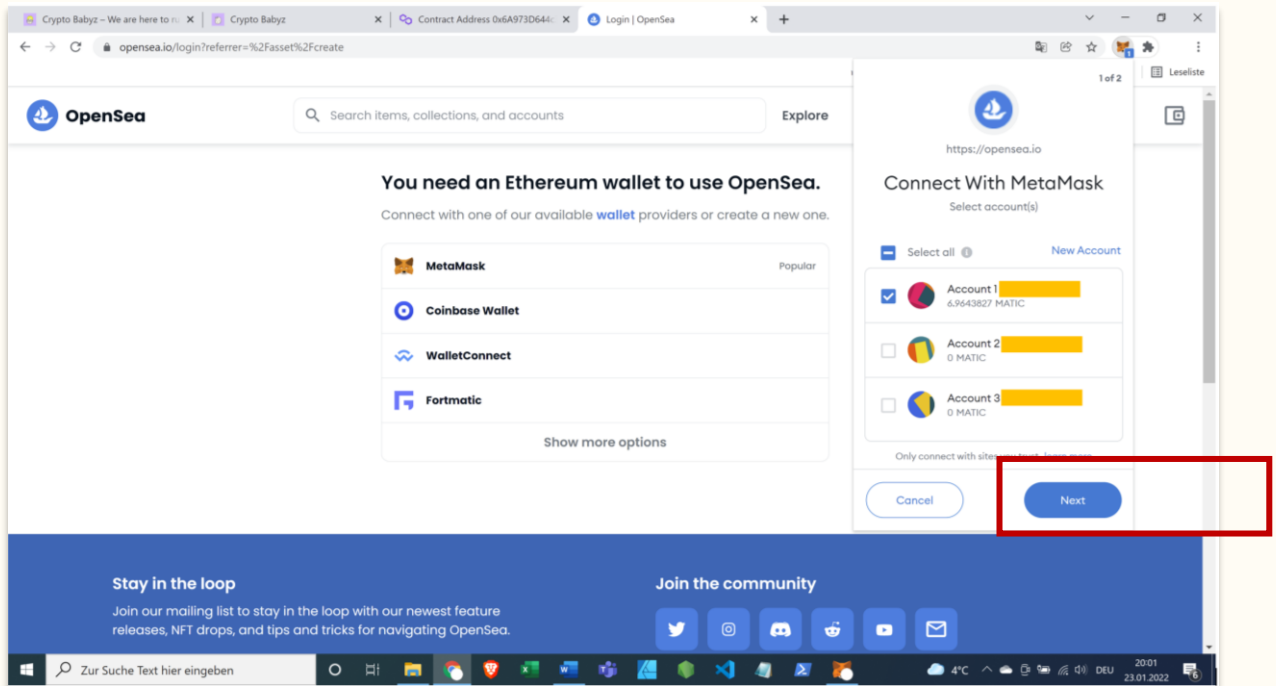
To view your recently minted Crypto Baby NFT, simply go to [www.opensea.io](http://www.opensea.io). In the top right corner there is a wallet symbol. Click it.



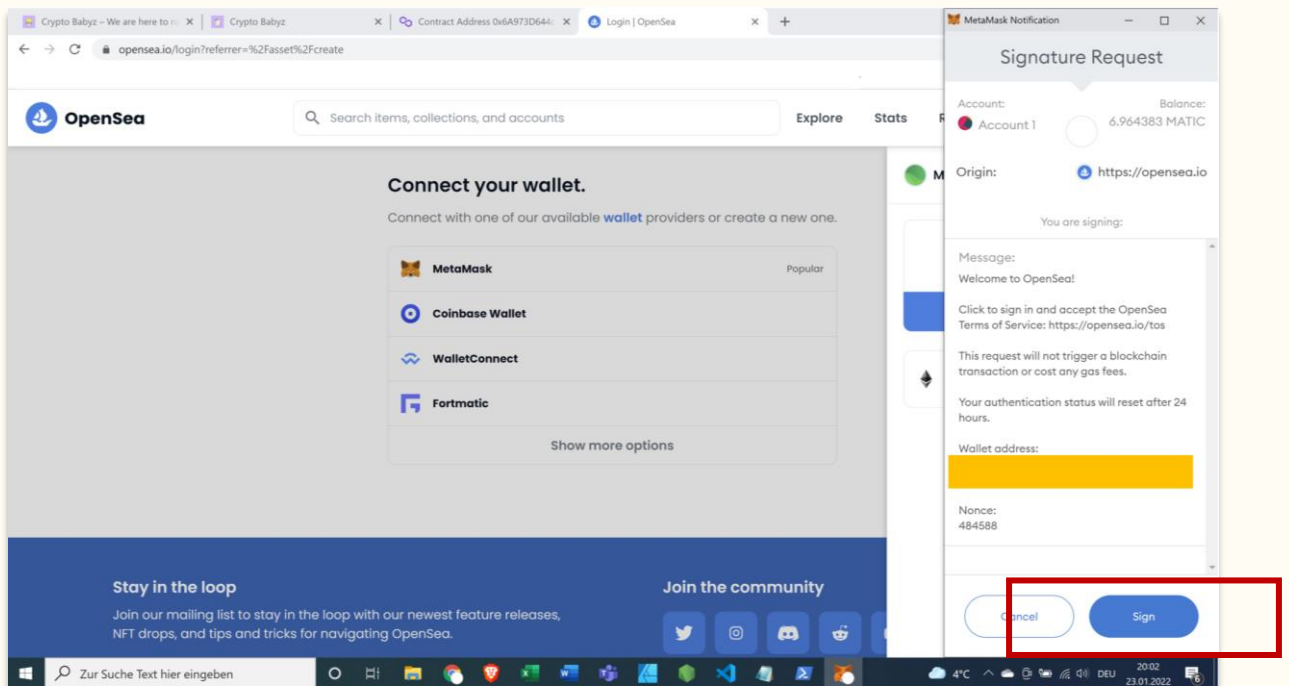
Choose the MetaMask wallet option.



Now your MetaMask wallet will pop up by itself, where you have to choose the account\* you want to connect to OpenSea. By clicking „next“, another window pops up.

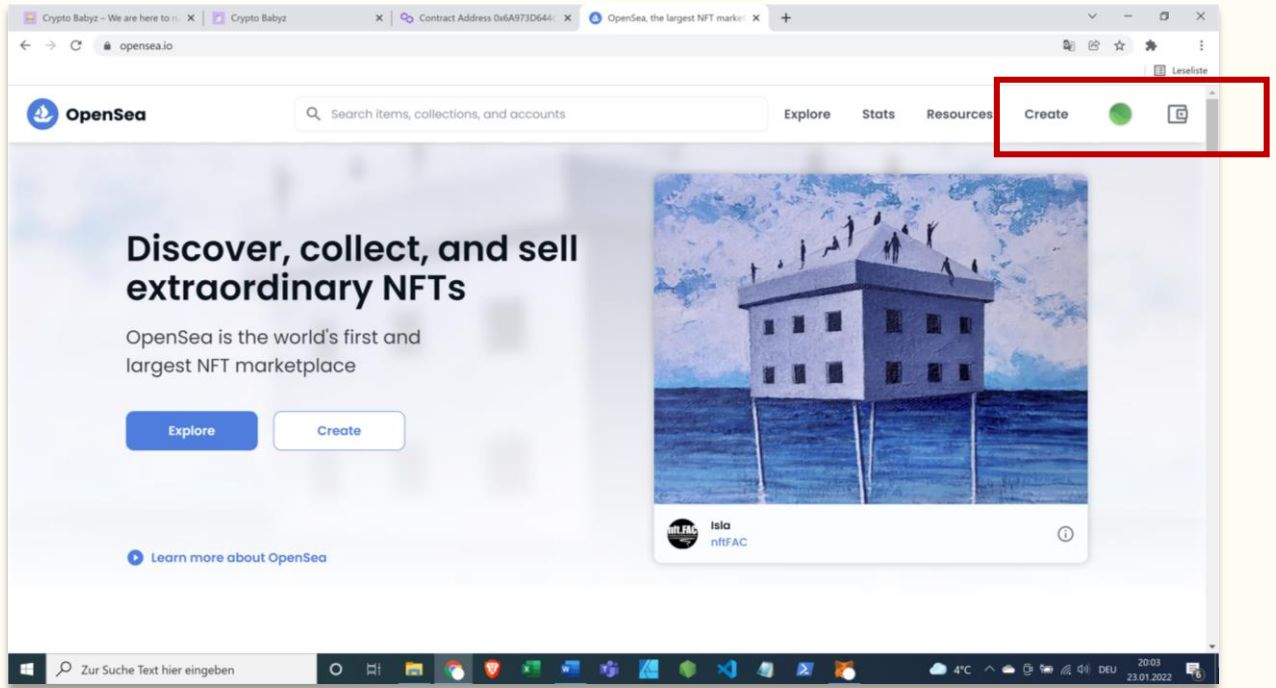


\*As a side note, you can have multiple accounts within one MetaMask wallet. Don't let it confuse you. Essentially, you only need one Account and that's it. So if you created only one account, you would only see „Account 1“, no Account 2 or 3.

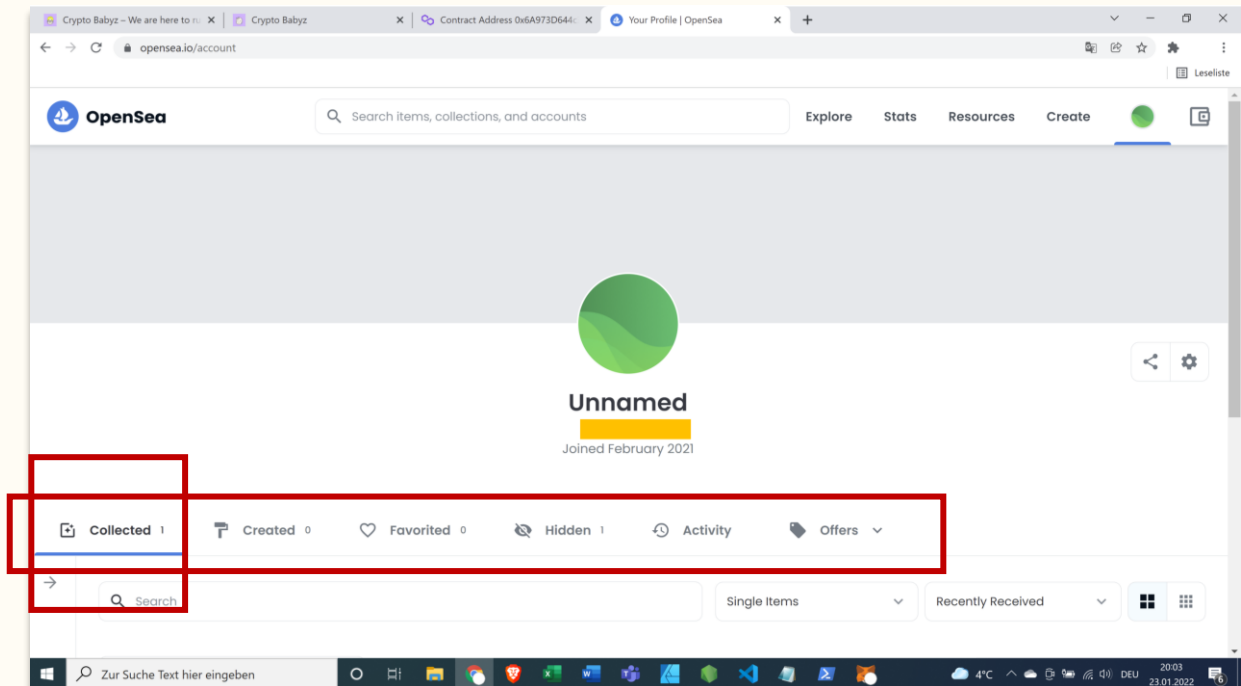


As seen in the picture above, this is a signature request, which asks you to „sign“ or in other words confirm the connection to OpenSea. Click „sign“ to finally connect your MetaMask wallet to OpenSea.

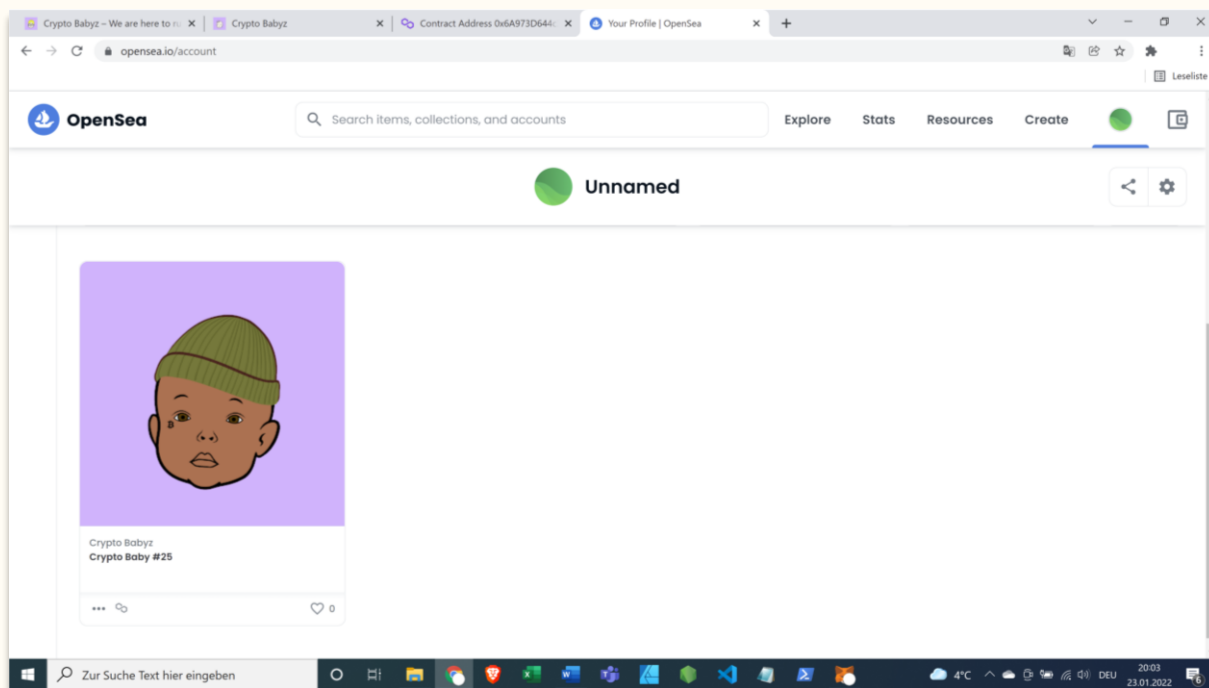
Now that your MetaMask wallet is connected to OpenSea, you are able to see a by default chosen profile picture in the top right corner. In this case it is displayed as green.



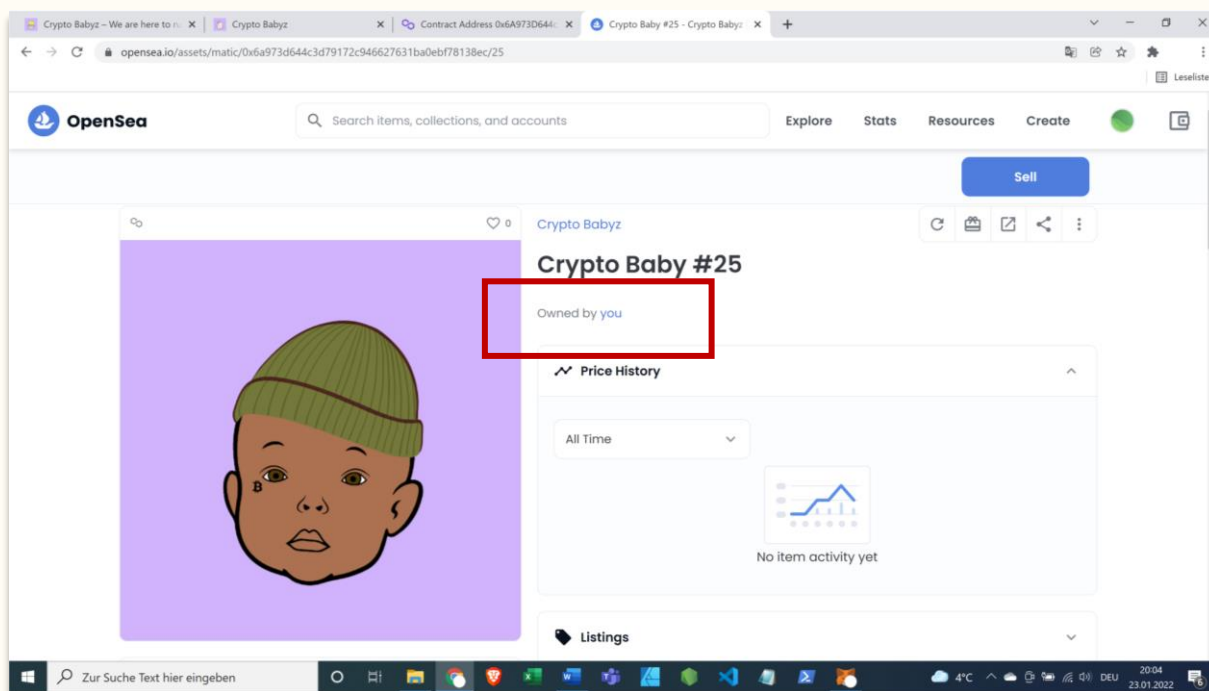
By clicking it, you get to your profile. You can give yourself a name if you'd like to – for demonstration purposes, we simply went with the default setting „unnamed“, as you can see below. The important part is, that you can see all your collected, created or favorited NFTs and even check your trading history and so on.



To finally see the Crypto Baby you just minted, click on „collected“ and scroll down. Tada! Below is our randomly minted Crypto Baby! Woohoo!

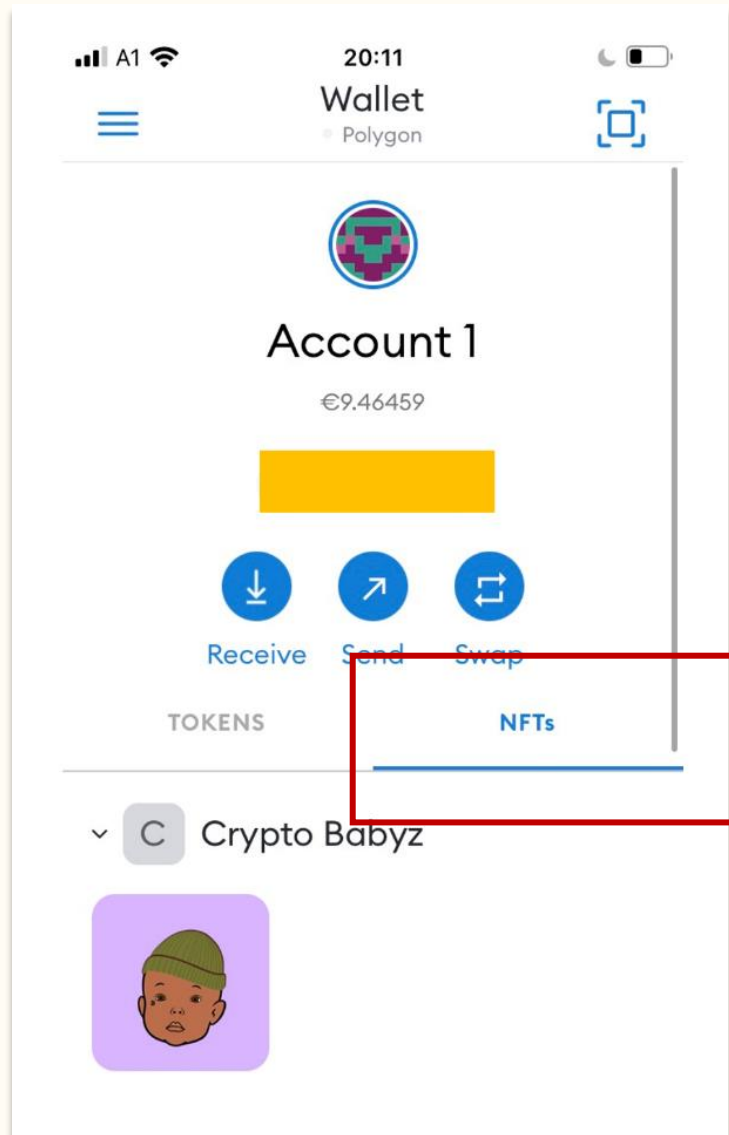


To see all the details concerning your Crypto Baby NFT as shown below, click on your Crypto Baby NFT. Further details can be the rarity of its characteristics (like a special hat or tattoo), its trading and price history, the current valuation and of course its current owner, which should be you.



As previously mentioned, it is not possible to view your Crypto Baby in the browser version of MetaMask yet. The only option is to connect your wallet to OpenSea and view your collected NFTs.

But you can view it in your mobile MetaMask wallet. Therefore, download and install MetaMask on your smartphone or Tablet and make sure to download it from the official MetaMask website. Then, connect to the Polygon Chain as you did in the browser extension. Mobile it will be displayed as follows:



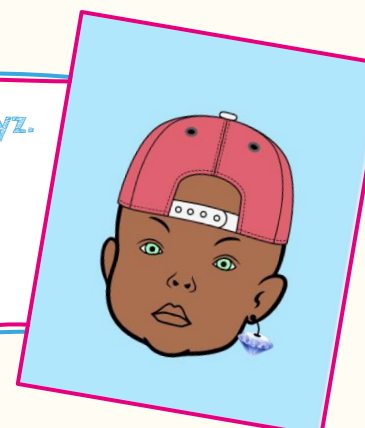
Here you can view your tokens and your NFTs. Therefore, tap on „NFTs“ and import your Crypto Baby, according to these instructions: <https://metamask.zendesk.com/hc/en-us/articles/360058238591-NFT-tokens-in-your-MetaMask-wallet>

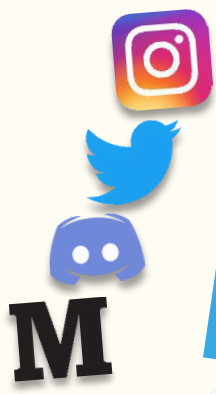
