

# The Na'vi Frequency Dictionary

## Na'vi - English

This is the dictionary that show the frequency of Na'vi words that were used at the LearnNa'vi.org forum. As there was the desire to know the most common Na'vi words, particularly for the beginners and also for the intermediate people in order to have a list of words of the Na'vi language that was created by Ph.D. Paul Frommer.

The advantage of this dictionary is to have a source of the frequency of the used Na'vi words. By this, the students and anyone who is still interested to know the Na'vi word frequency is welcome to use this work. This material can be used also as source for further projects that would need the word's frequency, like for teaching or creating applications.

Information about the source of words for the creation of this work are in the chapter below. In the past, there were some similar projects, but they had either not many words as source, used to be outdated or never been finished. Also, one or two of the old attempts had not the aim to have the word's frequency, rather the frequency of the letters.

## Source

The source of this of dictionary is the Community of LearnNa'vi.org. To have as many words as possible, I have chosen to collect Na'vi words from the forum threads of following boards:

- nìNa'vi nì'aw
- Pamtseo nìNa'vi nì'aw
- Pamrel nìNa'vi nì'aw

The total amount of collected (raw) words was around 250'000 which offered over 15'000 different word variations that had to be corrected, checked and evaluated. The fact that there is no kind of 'sorting program' that could be used as help to handle and get the data for this project, it was necessary to do *a lot* of manual work, in order to correct and evaluate the used words. This is the main reason for the fact that this project needed more than one year for its completion.

As mentioned, the sources of this work are the thousands of posts of the LN Community, which means that the words are originally written by members who do make mistakes – as everybody do – and additionally, there is the problem that the Na'vi language is still in development with the consequence that there were not all grammatical rules known to the members and were established with the time.

As for the case endings, there was no possibility to add all case endings that was used due to incorrect use of them, or they were used with illegal or unconfirmed words. However, I still added all valid affixes that were used.

## Used Methods

Now, a short explanation of how this work has been created. The Na'vi words were collected manually from the certain forum boards mentioned above. The last word has been collected on July 24, 2014, 06:27:19 pm [Houston Time (LN standard time), USA].

The sentences has been checked one time and added to a document to count the word's frequency. A little program (TextSTAT) has been used to get a very raw frequency list. The raw list was the file I started working on. I went through the list and extracted all affixes and attached adpositions, fixed thousands of typos and looked up hundreds of unclear words.

The result after one year of work is this document. It used 248'581 Na'vi words as valid source.
