2026 TOURNAMENT OFFICIALS

The officials assigned to this year's tournament are Kirk Drago, Shawn Payne, Chris Hill, Brad Vickers, Mark Harvey, Jordan Blair, Brian Napier and Jeff Adkins.

COMPLETED GAME

The game ends when the team behind in score has completed its turn at bat in the seventh inning, or any inning thereafter if extra innings are necessary. If the home team scores a go-ahead run in the bottom of the seventh inning, or in any extra inning, the game is terminated at that point. The game shall end when the losing team is behind 10 or more runs and has had at least five turns at bat and when the losing team has had an equal number of at bats, or a fifteen (15) run differential between teams after three innings.

INTERRUPTED GAME

If a game is interrupted, it will be reset at the same point, same inning, out or outs, ball or balls and strike or strikes with the same batter or number of batter in the batting order.

SPEED-UP RULES

Courtesy Runners

At any time the team at bat may use courtesy runners for the pitcher and/or the catcher. The same runner may not be used for both positions. Neither the pitcher nor the catcher will be required to leave the game under such circumstances.

Players who have participated in the game in any other capacity are ineligible to serve as courtesy runners.

A player may not run as a courtesy runner for the pitcher or the catcher and then be used as a substitute for another player in that half inning.

The umpire in chief shall record courtesy runner participation.

PITCHING LIMITATIONS

The KHSAA Pitching Limitation Rule is based on the number of pitches thrown in a game (for all interscholastic play including scrimmages, regular season and all rounds of postseason). Specific rest periods are in place when a pitcher reaches a threshold of pitches delivered in a day. The rest periods required during the regular and postseason are listed below:

VARSITY LEVEL PITCHES THROWN IN ONE DAY REQUIRED REST

- Maximum Pitches – 120
- 76 pitches or more – Three (3) calendar days of rest
- 51-75 – Two (2) calendar days of rest
- 26-50 – One (1) calendar day of rest
- 1-25 – No mandated rest
