2026 TOURNAMENT OFFICIALS

The officials assigned to this year's tournament are Matt Blackaby, Jared Combs, Buddy Fluhr, Mike Gayheart, Mark Hiten, Greg Kidd, Gregg Martin and Larry Thompson.

COMPLETED GAME

The game ends when the team behind in score has completed its turn at bat in the seventh inning, or any inning thereafter if extra innings are necessary. If the home team scores a go-ahead run in the bottom of the seventh inning, or in any extra inning, the game is terminated at that point.

Games will be played in accordance with mercy rules. A fifteen (15) run differential between teams after three innings or a ten (10) run differential after five innings will finish/complete the game. The international tie-breaker will not be used during postseason play.

INTERRUPTED GAME

If a game is interrupted, it will be reset at the same point, same inning, out or outs, ball or balls and strike or strikes with the same batter or number of batter in the batting order.

SPEED UP RULES

Courtesy Runners

At any time the team at bat may use courtesy runners for the pitcher and/or the catcher. The same runner may not be used for both positions. Neither the pitcher nor the catcher will be required to leave the game under such circumstances.

Players who have participated in the game in any other capacity are ineligible to serve as courtesy runners.

A player may not run as a courtesy runner for the pitcher or the catcher and then be used as a substitute for another player in that half inning.

The umpire in chief shall record courtesy runner participation.
