TUESDAY:

READ: *Ephesians 2:1-10*

What's the greatest gift you've been given? Being saved by grace through faith means salvation isn't our own doing but a gift from God. Although salvation is a gift, God has plans for each of us that He longs to see us fulfill. Answer the questions below:

- Q: How is God described, according to this passage?
- Q: What is the devil doing, according to this passage?
- Q: How are we described in verse 10?
- Q: What is one good thing God has planned for you today?

WEDNESDAY

READ: *Psalms 119:9-11*

Today's text highlights the value of deeply knowing and following God's word. Doing so will help us maintain purity and avoid sin. Are you searching for God today? And when He is found, will you obey Him? Answer the questions below:

- Q: How would you rewrite the question of verse 9 in your own words?
- Q: What do you think purity means?
- Q: Describe a recent time you've strayed from the Lord.
- Q: What does verse 11 tell us helps with avoiding sin?

THURSDAY

READ: *Ephesians 4:29-32*

Do you ever feel like some people are harder to love than others? Would someone say the same for you? Today's verse highlights the importance of moral excellence as it relates to kindness, compassion and forgiveness. Answer the questions below:

- Q: What do you spend the majority of your time talking about? Is God honored in that?
- Q: How might the world's definition of kindness and God's definition be different?
- Q: What must we be willing to do in order to forgive someone, as verse 32 indicates?
- Q: Who or what circumstance do you need to forgive today?

FRIDAY

READ: *James 2:14-17*

Spiritual growth that happens at camp is meant to propel you into greater obedience as you return home. Write down three specific things the Lord taught you this week and how you plan to apply those truths to your life. Spend time intentionally praying over each action item.
