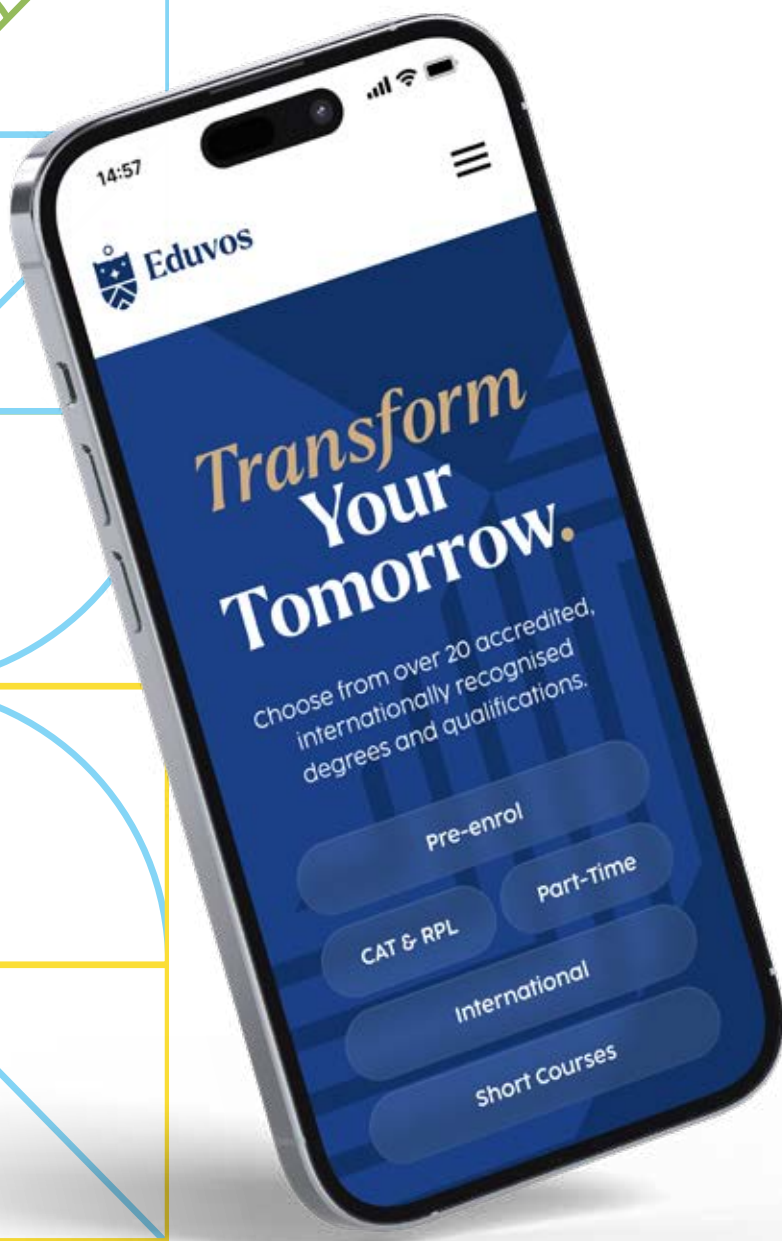

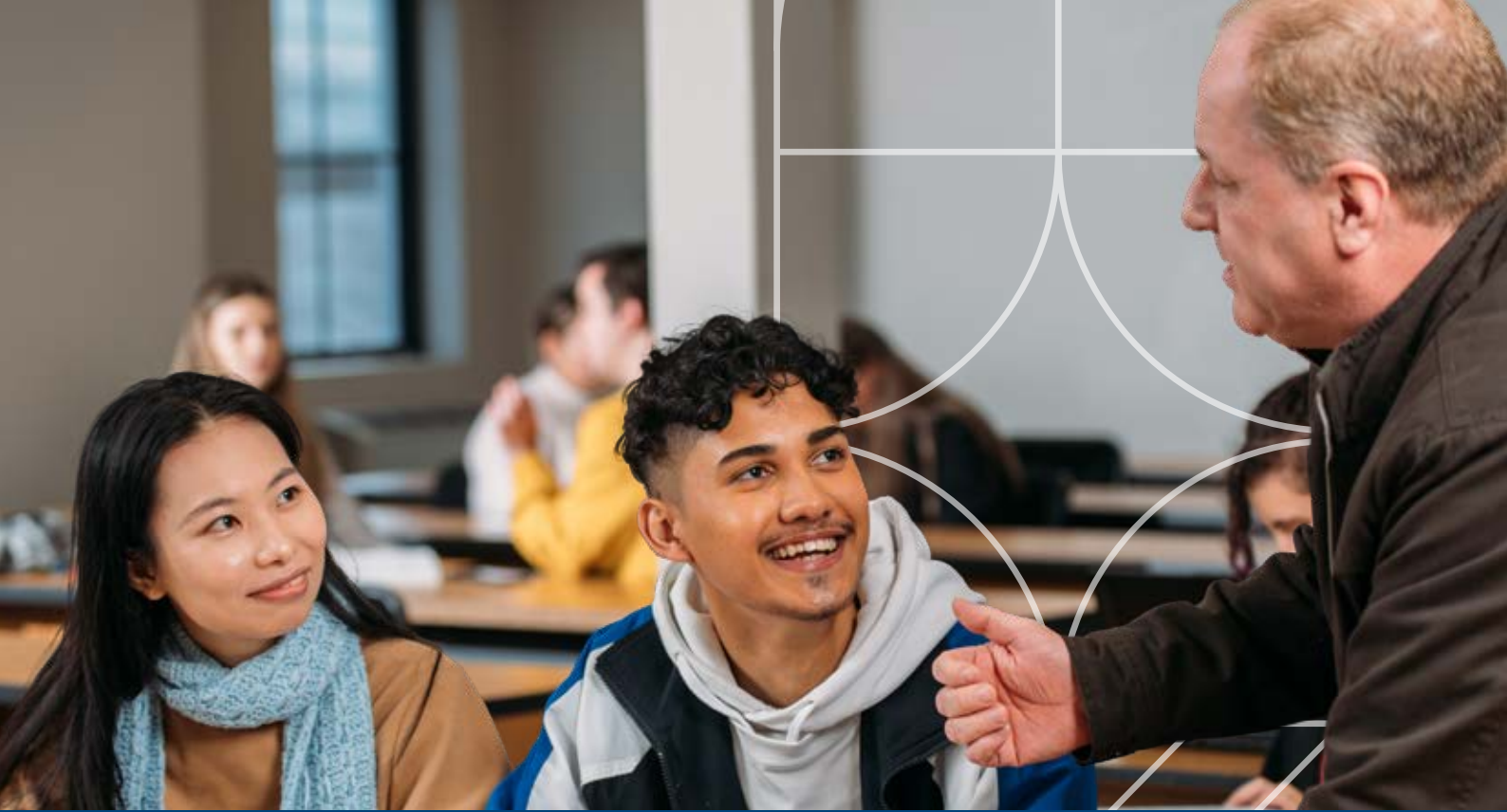

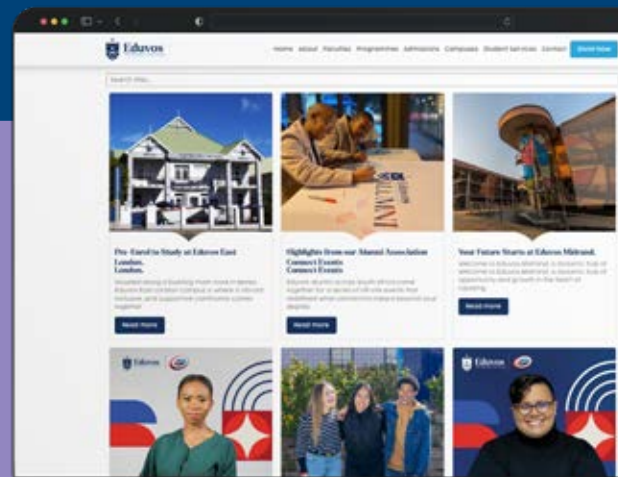

Real-world impact is the driving force behind the Research Agenda 2023–2027, guided by our mission of “Empowering Sustainable Development in Africa.” We believe research must meaningfully improve lives by advancing equity (by addressing systemic barriers and promoting inclusive opportunities), strengthening institutions (through evidence-based policies and capacity building), and enabling sustainable growth (via innovation, entrepreneurship, and environmental stewardship), while shaping graduates who are ready to lead in an innovation-driven world.

In the evolving landscape of higher education, research is important in tackling societal challenges, fostering sustainable development, and enriching curricula that equip students for the future. Eduvos is committed to producing scholarship that moves beyond publication to application. To ensure our work has measurable and lasting value, we align our efforts with the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), the African Union’s Agenda 2063, and the SADC Vision 2050, translating global priorities into local action. In line with this, Eduvos is a proud participant in the Department of Higher Education and Training’s University Capacity Development Programme. Our approach to integrating AI into higher education is rooted in ethics, adaptability, and innovation. Beyond the classroom, our academic content writers are exploring emerging technologies such as generative AI to enhance learning materials, always within Eduvos' quality assurance framework and with academic integrity at the core of every process. To strengthen this commitment, we established a dedicated AI committee that includes academic staff, student representatives, support teams, and IT professionals. This committee explores AI's opportunities and risks, and drafts policies to ensure Eduvos remains a leader in shaping responsible, future-fit education.

# Modes of Learning.

We understand every student's journey is unique. Through a combination of campus-based and online learning, our hybrid model provides a dynamic, engaging higher education experience that allows you to study in a way that suits your lifestyle and goals.

Modes of learning, or modes of provision, define how students engage with curricula, lecturers, supervisors, and peers, shaping the structure of teaching and learning. Eduvos follows a mixed-mode approach that incorporates both hybrid and distance-based learning, with individual programmes accredited as hybrid, or distance provision, in line with CHE and DHET regulations. Regardless of the mode, all Eduvos academic offerings must maintain the same quality standards, ensuring an active, engaged, and participatory learning experience.

## Campus Full-Time (Hybrid Learning)

Students attend synchronous (live) lectures on weekdays at an Eduvos campus. Our hybrid model blends on-campus and online learning, with most undergraduate programmes following a one week on campus, one week online rotation. This alternates between in-person classes and online classes via Microsoft Teams (MS Teams). Students also use myLMS (our online learning platform) for self-directed study and preparation.

At honours level, hybrid full-time programmes are offered at our Midrand campus (subject to minimum numbers), with students attending on-campus lectures every second week or participating fully online via MS Teams.



## Online

For students needing flexibility, online includes live lectures on MS Teams. Students use our myLMS portal to access learning materials. Online qualifications are available full-time or part-time. Full-time students enrol for three or four modules per block, while part-time students typically enrol for one or two modules per block.

### Online Full-Time\*

As a full-time student, dedicating sufficient time to your studies is essential. Expect a typical workload of at least 120 credits per academic year, which allows for completion of qualifications within the minimum duration: one year for a higher certificate or an honours degree, and three years for a bachelor's degree.

### Online Part-Time\*

As a part-time student, your workload will typically involve fewer than 120 credits per academic year, enabling you to complete your qualification over a longer period: two years for a higher certificate or an honours degree and up to five years for a bachelor's degree.

## Distance

Distance students study at their own pace without mandatory live lectures, but optional consultation sessions with lecturers are available. Students interact via myLMS discussion forums, and recorded lectures can be accessed anytime.

With our Bachelor of Laws (LLB), you can join optional, synchronous national online lectures each week, led by subject matter experts. In addition, optional, campus-based support sessions provide hands-on learning through tutorials and case discussions.

All lectures and sessions are recorded, allowing you to review content at your own pace and reinforce your understanding.

# Modes of Learning.

## Academic Calendar and Four-Block Model

Our academic year is divided into four blocks, allowing students to focus on fewer modules at a time to support stronger academic performance. Each block includes seven lecture weeks, followed by an assessment period. Before lectures commence (week zero), students are required to engage with course content on myLMS. Supplementary assessments are scheduled either before or after the next block, in line with the academic calendar. You can start your studies in any of our block intakes.

## Start Anytime

With our Start Anytime option, you don't need to wait for the next intake to begin your studies. This flexible enrolment pathway is available for a range of programmes, giving you the freedom to get started right away.

If you miss an enrolment deadline, you can begin immediately with a foundational, self-directed, credit-bearing module. The module combines recorded lectures with live weekly Q&A sessions, so you can learn at your own pace while still receiving personal academic support.

After completing the module, you will move seamlessly into your main academic block, following the four-block model in your chosen mode of learning.

If you did not achieve a bachelor's pass in your matric results, you still have a pathway to success at Eduvos. Our pre-degree programmes are tailored to help you build the skills and foundational knowledge required to progress into a degree.

### Minimum admission requirements for undergraduate degrees:

- You must pass at least six out of seven subjects with a minimum of:
  - 40% or Level 3 for your Home Language;
  - 50% or Level 4 for four other high credit subjects (excluding Life Orientation);
  - 30% or Level 2 for two other subjects.
- Alternatively, an endorsement on your NSC may grant you admission into a higher certificate or foundation programme.

## National Certificate Vocational (Level 4) admission requirements.

### For admission into a higher certificate or foundation programme:

- You must pass seven subjects by achieving a minimum of:
  - 40% in English Home Language;
  - 30% minimum in Mathematics/Mathematical Literacy;
  - 40% in Life Orientation;
  - 50% in each of your four vocational subjects.

### For admission into a bachelor's degree:

- You must have achieved a minimum of 60% in three fundamental subjects (English, Mathematics, Mathematical Literacy, or Technical Mathematics, and Life Orientation).
- You must have a minimum of 70% in the four Vocational subjects, chosen from the NC(V) registered subject list.

The NC(V) Level 4 subjects must relate to the degree for which you intend to enrol.

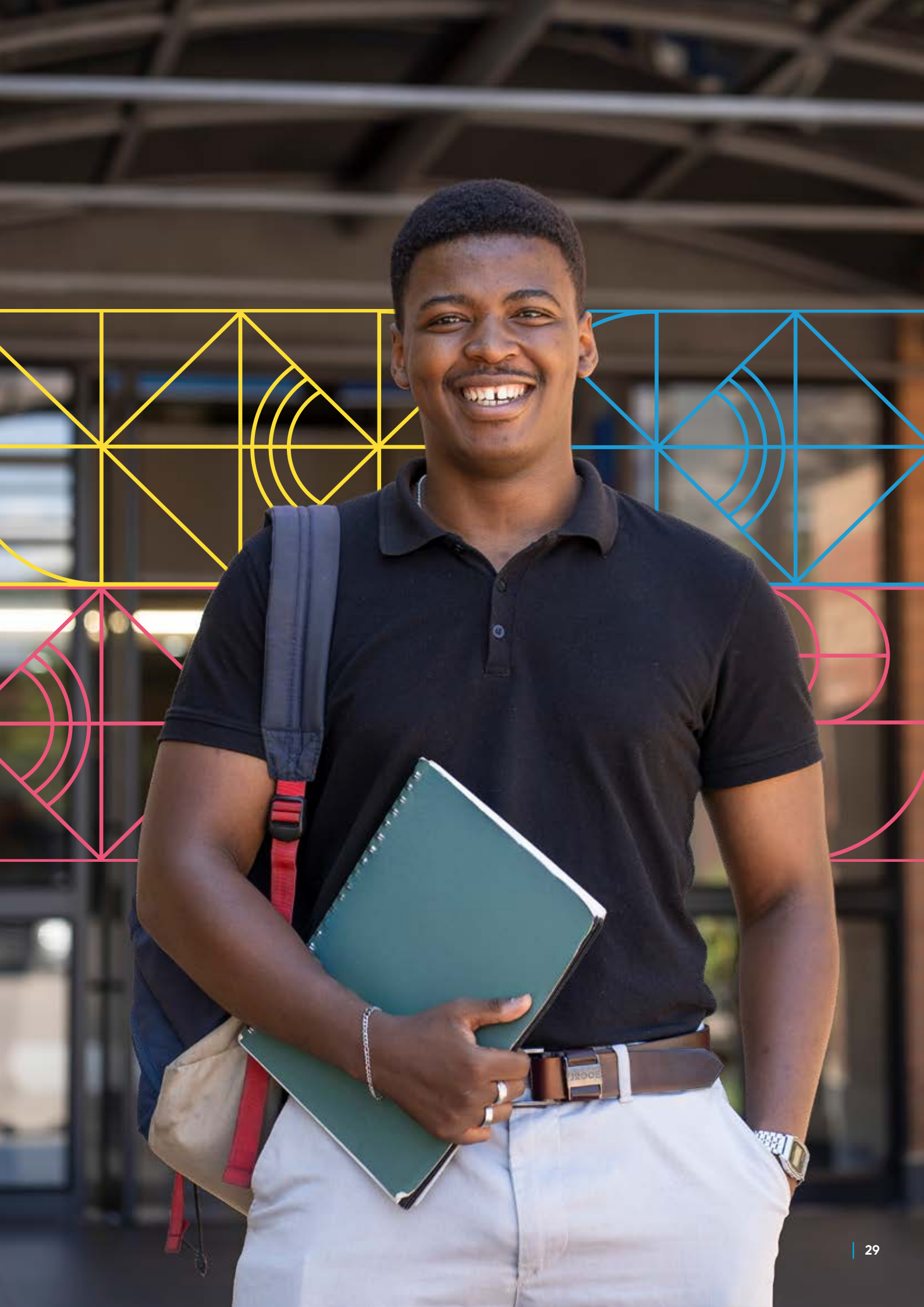

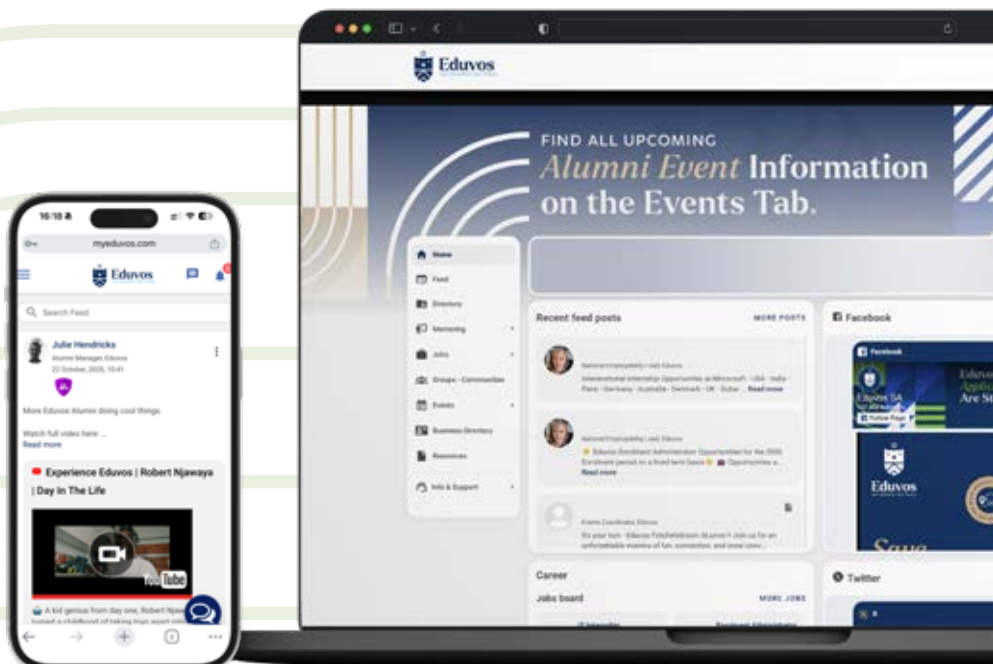
