

# PRIVACY POLICY

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This Privacy Policy explains how Safety National Casualty Corporation and its subsidiaries (“**Safety National**,” “**us**,” “**we**,” or “**our**”) collects, uses, and discloses personal information in connection with our website (www.safetynational.com) and other services we provide (collectively, our “**Services**”).

In addition to the disclosures in this Privacy Policy, if you are a resident of California, then you should also review the additional provisions of Appendix 1 (the “**California Privacy Notice**”). To the extent the provisions of this Privacy Policy conflict or are inconsistent with the provisions set out in an Appendix applicable to you, the provisions in that Appendix shall control.

### 1. **Definitions**

“**CCPA**” means the California Consumer Privacy Act of 2018, as amended by the California Privacy Rights Act of 2020, and any regulations issued thereunder.

“**Privacy Policy**” means this Privacy Policy, supplemented as applicable by the provisions set forth in Appendix 1 (the California Privacy Notice).

“**Personal information**” means any information that identifies, relates to, describes, is reasonably capable of being associated with, or could reasonably be linked, directly or indirectly, with a particular consumer or household. Personal information does not include information that is publicly available, deidentified, or aggregated. When we use deidentified data, we commit to maintaining the data in deidentified form and will not attempt to reidentify it, except as allowed by law.

“**Processing**” means any operation or set of operations which is performed upon personal information, whether or not by automatic means, such as collection, recording, organization, structuring, storage, adaptation or alteration, retrieval, consultation, use, disclosure by transmission, dissemination or otherwise making available, alignment or combination, restriction, erasure or destruction.

### 2. **Personal Information We Collect**

We collect and process personal information from or about the following categories of individuals:

- Users of our website;
- Individuals associated with our insureds, potential insureds, business clients, potential business clients, brokers, third-party administrators, vendors, regulators, and other entities with which we interact;
- Claimants and related persons under insurance policies;

- Our employees, potential employees, contractors and consultants.

We may collect, process, and store various types of personal information about you, depending on your relationship with us. The following is a general summary of the personal information about you that we may process, the sources of such personal information, and the purposes for our processing:

## **2.1. Website Users**

If you use our website, we may collect personal information from you and/or about your activities on our website (“**Website Data**”).

Types of Personal Information: When you visit our website, we may collect two types of Website Data: (i) personal information about you that you voluntarily provide to us, and (ii) information about your activities on our website that we collect automatically as you interact with the website.

- Information You Voluntarily Provide: We collect personal information that you voluntarily provide at various places through our website. The personal information we collect is business-oriented data and is usually limited to contact information necessary for the relationship, such as name, company name, job title, and email address. We may collect such information, for example, when you fill out and submit a form, register for our Services or an account, report a claim, apply for a job, register to receive our email communications, or submit an inquiry or request to us.
- Information We Collect Automatically: We use cookies to collect and store information about your interactions with our website, including information about your browsing behavior. Cookies are small files that a website transfers to your device through a web browser that enable the site’s or a third party’s systems to recognize your device and capture and remember certain information. Our website uses the following types of cookies:
  - (a) Necessary Cookies. These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website. They include, for example, cookies that enable the website to perform as intended and to access secure areas of our website.
  - (b) Functional Cookies. These cookies enable our website to provide enhanced functionality and personalization. They may be set by us or by service providers whose services we have added to our pages. If you do not allow these cookies, some or all of these features may not function properly.
  - (c) Analytical/Performance Cookies. These cookies allow us to recognize and count the number of visitors to our website, see how visitors move around our website, see which search engines are being used to find our website, the region a visitor is browsing from, and the type of device a user is using, among other information. This helps us to improve our website, for example, by ensuring that users can easily find what they are looking for. We may use service providers, including Google Analytics, to provide analytics services. Google Analytics is owned and controlled by Google LLC. Data collected by Google is subject to its privacy policy. You may opt out of having your website activity made available to Google Analytics by installing the [Google Analytics browser add-on](#).
  - (d) Advertising Cookies. These cookies may be set through our website by us or by our advertising partners, and are used to target advertisements on our behalf or for other related purposes. One of the tools we may use for this purpose is Google Ads, which is an advertising service provided by Google. You can personalize the ads you receive or opt out of ads from Google by visiting the [Google Ads Settings](#)

page. Additional options for opting out of interest-based advertising can be found [here](#).

Cookies vary in how long they last. Session cookies terminate shortly after you end your internet session. Persistent cookies are stored on your device until a set expiration date. We use both session cookies and persistent cookies on our website.

If you would prefer not to receive cookies, most browsers allow you to change your cookie settings to block cookies. These settings will typically be found in the “options” or “preferences” menu of your browser, but please know that blocking all cookies may have an impact on the functionality of our website.

- Information about Children. Neither the Safety National website nor any of our products or Services are directed to children younger than age eighteen (18).
- Do Not Track. We do not monitor or take any action with respect to Do Not Track signals.

Purposes for Processing: We process Website Data for the purposes of building relationships with existing and potential clients and/or insureds and other interested parties, communicating with such parties, marketing and advertising our products and Services, and analyzing and improving the Safety National website.

## **2.2. Insureds, Potential Insureds, Business Clients, Potential Business Clients, Brokers, Third-Party Administrators, Vendors, and Other Business Contacts**

We collect and process personal information about individuals associated with our insureds, potential insureds, business clients, potential business clients, brokers, third-party administrators, vendors, and other entities with which we may interact from time to time (“**Contact Data**”).

Types of Contact Data: The Contact Data that we collect and process typically consists of information such as name, title, position, employer, email address, other business contact data (e.g., business card data), and similar relationship type data. Such Contact Data may also include details of your business interactions with us.

Sources of Contact Data: We obtain Contact Data about you (i) directly from you, such as when you contact us about our Services, or when you or your organization provide or offer to provide services to us, (ii) from others (e.g., referrals), (iii) from third parties, such as government agencies, and (iv) from publicly available sources, such as websites (e.g., LinkedIn, your company’s website, etc.).

Purposes for Processing: We process Contact Data for the purposes of obtaining services from vendors and third-party administrators, providing services to insureds, building and managing relationships with brokers, existing and potential business clients, regulators, and other interested parties, communicating with such parties, and generally operating our business.

## **2.3. Claimants and Related Persons**

In the course of issuing insurance policies and processing claims, we may receive personal information provided by or on behalf of individual claimants and other persons in connection with those policies (“**Claimant Data**”).

Types of Claimant Data: The scope and extent of the Claimant Data that we collect and process is typically determined by the client and/or the nature and scope of the insurance services provided under the applicable insurance policy. Such Claimant Data typically includes the personal information necessary to process a claim, such as personal records and contact information, information about the nature of the claim, health and medical information,

professional or employment information, education information, demographic information, information about insurance benefits, and other related information.

Sources of Claimant Data: We obtain Claimant Data directly from our insureds, and from third parties and service providers that provide such information on behalf of our insureds, such as certain vendors, brokers and third-party administrators.

Purposes for Processing: We process Claimant Data for the purposes of issuing and fulfilling our commitments under our insurance policies.

#### **2.4. Employees, Potential Employees, Contractors, Potential Contractors, Consultants, and Potential Consultants**

If you apply for employment with Safety National (whether as an employee, contractor, or consultant), when we evaluate your employment application and related materials (e.g., the results of pre-employment screenings), and thereafter throughout the course of your employment, contract or consulting arrangement, we may obtain personal information about you as follows (“HR Data”). California employees and job applicants, please click [here](#) for our California Employee and Applicant Privacy Notice.

Types of HR Data: The HR Data we collect varies based on whether you receive a job offer and by the roles and responsibilities that you undertake with Safety National. It may include:

- Individual Data: Your name, address, telephone and/or mobile telephone number, email address, foreign language skills, relevant tax identification number(s), information on your passport, driver’s license or other governmental identification, information contained in a governmental employment eligibility form, prior employers, education, prior employment history, results of criminal background screening, visa information, emergency contact information, name change information, CVs, etc.;
- Job-Related Data: Job-related data such as your payroll and salary information, benefits and pension information, dependent and beneficiary information you provide, tax and government reporting information, information about your performance on the job, including awards, appraisals, warnings, individual and management development plans and reviews, and information relating to promotions and position changes (including requests), information regarding your compliance with company policies and certifications;
- Special Categories of HR Data: Your racial or ethnic origin, religion or creed, professional association or union membership, data concerning health (e.g., benefits or leave information, information on pregnancy or disabilities in order to comply with legal requirements), physical or mental disability, veteran or military status, gender, gender identity or gender expression, marital status, date of birth/age, citizenship, national origin, and data that you may voluntarily submit concerning your sexual orientation; and
- Other Data About You: Any additional personal information that may be included on documents you submit or we obtain as part of your employment application or throughout the course of your employment, such as information contained on any employment application or cover letter, curriculum vitae or resume, diploma, transcript, license, statement of good behavior, background screening, employment contract, any related documents, reference check, identification card, request for leave, benefits, wage garnishment and other similar court-ordered information, etc., and information collected from publicly available resources, professional license databases, and credit agencies, where applicable.

Sources of HR Data: We obtain HR Data about you (i) directly from you, (ii) from other employees at Safety National (e.g., performance reviews), and (iii) from third parties, such as government

agencies, recruiters, employment agencies, screening companies, and references that you provide to us, as well as from publicly available sources, such as websites.

Purposes for Processing: Your HR Data is processed for the purpose of establishing and maintaining your employment relationship with us (whether as an employee, contractor, or consultant).

### **3. Disclosures of Personal Information**

We may disclose personal information about you to the following parties or in the following circumstances:

#### **3.1. Service Providers**

We may disclose personal information about you to vendors and other business partners who perform services for us or on our behalf, for the purpose of carrying out such services. This includes, without limitation, vendors that assist in managing our organization, hosting or administering our website or electronic systems, sending communications on our or our insureds' behalf, maintaining or analyzing data, and providing marketing assistance. It also includes businesses providing services for anti-money laundering, credit risk reduction, fraud and crime prevention and other similar services, including financial institutions, background check agencies, and other vendors.

#### **3.2. Other Parties**

We may disclose selected personal information about you to insureds, regulators, legal counsel, experts, consultants, law enforcement personnel, and other persons or entities to the extent reasonably necessary or appropriate in the context of providing insurance services for our insureds or otherwise operating our business.

#### **3.3. Corporate Change**

We reserve the right to disclose and transfer personal information about you in connection with a merger, consolidation, restructuring, financing, sale, or other organizational change involving some or all of our assets.

#### **3.4. Legal Requirements and Law Enforcement**

We may disclose personal information about you when we believe, in good faith, that the law requires it; at the request of governmental authorities conducting an audit or investigation; pursuant to a court order, subpoena, or discovery request in litigation; to verify or enforce compliance with our agreements or policies and applicable laws, rules, and regulations; or whenever we believe disclosure is necessary to limit our legal liability or to protect or enforce the rights, interests, or security of Safety National, its users, or other third parties. We also reserve the right to report to law enforcement agencies any activities that we, in good faith, believe to be unlawful.

#### **3.5. Consent**

We may also disclose personal information about you in accordance with any consent you or your authorized agent give us.

### **4. Security of Personal Information**

At no cost to you, we have implemented appropriate technical and organizational measures (i) to ensure a level of security appropriate to the risks that are presented by Safety National's processing of personal information, in particular from accidental or unlawful destruction, loss, alteration, unauthorized disclosure of, or access to personal information transmitted, stored or

otherwise processed, and (ii) to ensure the ongoing confidentiality, integrity, availability and resilience of processing systems and services for the personal information.

#### **5. Social Security Data**

It is our policy to protect the confidentiality of Social Security numbers in our possession from misuse and improper disclosure by maintaining and enforcing policies and physical and electronic safeguards against their misuse or improper disclosure. Unlawful disclosure of Social Security numbers is prohibited, and access to them is limited to Safety National personnel who need access to such information in order to perform their job functions.

#### **6. International Visitors**

Our website and this Privacy Policy are directed to residents of the United States. If you access our website from outside the United States, please be aware that your personal information may be transferred to, stored, and processed in the United States, and that the data protection and other laws of the United States may not be as comprehensive as those of your country.

#### **7. Changes to the Privacy Policy**

Safety National reserves the right to modify or amend this Privacy Policy at any time. The current version of the Privacy Policy will be published on our website.

In addition to the purposes described above, we may use and disclose any category of personal information or sensitive personal information we collect to respond to law enforcement requests,

or as otherwise required or authorized by applicable law, court order, or governmental regulations; to protect our rights and interests and those of others; to resolve any disputes; to enforce our policies; and to evaluate or conduct a merger, sale, or other organizational change involving some or all of our assets.

Safety National does not knowingly collect, process, store, or maintain personal information about consumers under 18.

### **How Long We Keep Your Personal Information**

We keep the categories of personal information described above for as long as necessary or permitted for the purposes described in this Notice or otherwise authorized by law. This generally means holding the information for as long as one of the following apply:

- Your personal information is reasonably necessary to manage our operations, to manage your relationship with us, or to satisfy another purpose for which we collected the information;
- Your personal information is reasonably necessary to carry out a disclosed purpose that is reasonably compatible with the context in which the personal information was collected;
- The personal information is reasonably necessary to protect or defend our rights or property (which will generally relate to applicable laws that limit actions in a particular case); or
- We are otherwise required or permitted to keep your personal information by applicable laws or regulations.

Where personal information is used for more than one purpose, we will retain it until the purpose with the latest period expires.

### **How We Disclose Personal Information**

We do not sell personal information or share it for cross-context behavioral advertising. We may disclose each of the categories of personal information we collect to our service providers and contractors for the following business and commercial purposes:

- Performing services (including processing, maintaining, or collecting personal information) on our behalf related to the purposes for which we collect each category of personal information as described above (e.g., providing communications, technical, analytical, web hosting, data storage, application support, vendor management, billing and payment processing, customer support, claims administration, accounting, auditing, insurance, legal, security, or other services)
- Ensuring security and integrity of personal information
- Debugging to identify and repair errors that impair existing intended functionality
- Short-term, transient use, including, but not limited to, non-personalized advertising
- Providing advertising or marketing services on our behalf
- Auditing related to ad impressions
- Undertaking internal research for technological development and demonstration
- Undertaking activities to verify or maintain the quality or safety of our products and Services
- To comply with applicable laws and regulations
- For safety and security
- Detecting, protecting against, or addressing malicious, deceptive, fraudulent, or illegal activity

We disclose sensitive personal information for more limited purposes, including: when necessary to provide our products or Services; services performed on our behalf related to the operation of

our business and/or the Services; ensuring security and integrity of personal information; undertaking activities to verify or maintain the quality or safety of our Services; to comply with applicable laws and regulations; for safety and security; detecting, protecting against, or addressing malicious, deceptive, fraudulent, or illegal activity.

### **California Privacy Rights**

If you are a resident of California, you have the right to submit certain requests relating to your personal information as described below. To exercise any of these rights, please submit a request through our [webform](#) or call us at 1-877-270-1126. You will be asked to provide personal information that we will match against our records to verify your identity. You may designate an authorized agent to make a request on your behalf; however, you will still need to verify your identity directly with us before your request can be processed. An authorized agent may submit a request on your behalf using the webform or toll-free number listed above.

**Right to Know.** You have the right to know what personal information we have collected about you, which includes:

- The categories of personal information we have collected about you
  - The categories of sources from which the personal information was collected
  - Our business or commercial purposes for collecting or disclosing personal information
  - The categories of recipients to which we disclose personal information
  - The categories of personal information that we disclosed for a business purpose, and for each category identified, the categories of service providers and contractors to which we disclosed that particular category of personal information
- The specific pieces of personal information we have collected about you

**Right to Delete Your Personal Information.** You have the right to request that we delete personal information we collected from you, subject to certain exceptions. Where deidentification is used to satisfy a deletion request, we commit to maintaining and using the information in deidentified form and will not attempt to reidentify the information.

**Right to Correct Inaccurate Information.** If you believe that personal information we maintain about you is inaccurate, you have the right to request that we correct that information.

**Right to Limit Use and Disclosure of Sensitive Personal Information.** We do not use or disclose sensitive personal information for purposes to which the right to limit use and disclosure applies under the CCPA.

**Right to Non-Discrimination for the Exercise of Your Privacy Rights.** If you choose to exercise any of your privacy rights under the CCPA, you also have the right not to receive discriminatory treatment by us, including retaliation against you in relation to your employment or potential employment with us.
