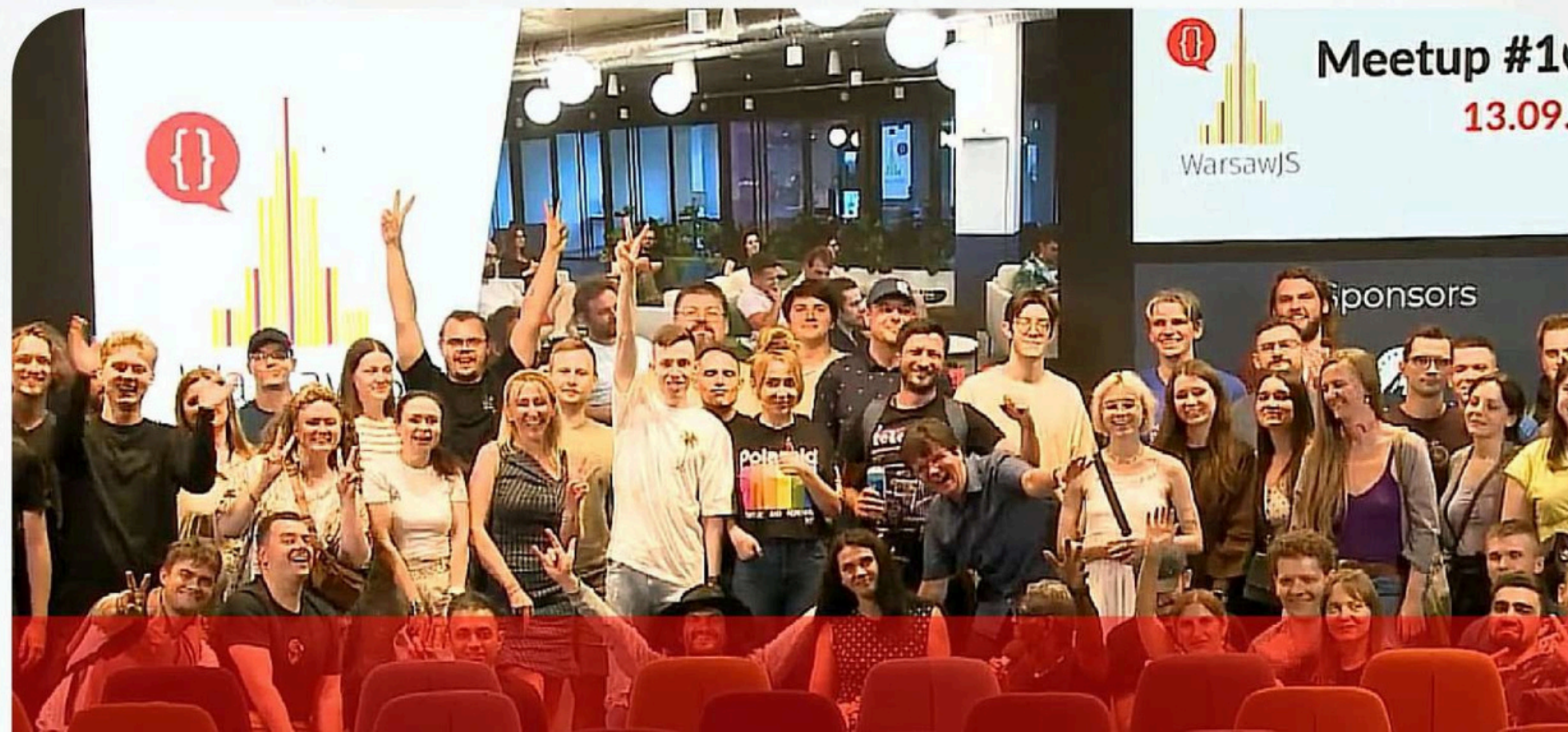

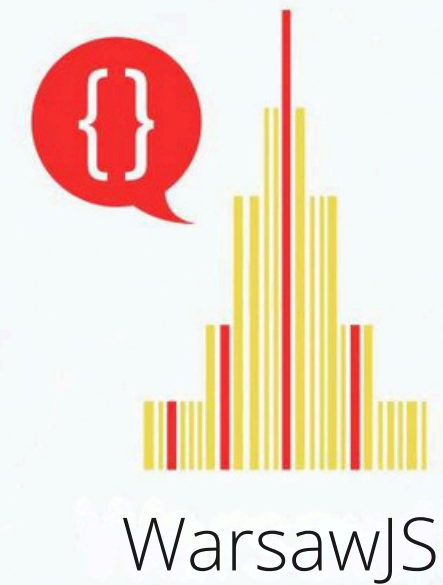

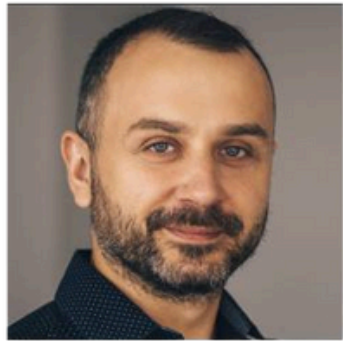
We exchange knowledge on dedicated channels to help each other find better solutions & plan everyday activities.
