 - Final Round:
 - Topic: To be announced on the spot
- Time: 20 minutes for preparation, 6 minutes for presentation. (Global perspectives related to Environmentally sustainable and responsible lifestyle choices, Economic Policies, Social Issues, War and Peace, Armed Conflicts,etc.)
- Participants will not be allowed to use any external material or notes, as reference during the presentation.
- Judges will ask questions and may provide feedback on your presentation.
- Exceeding the time limit of 6 mins (for the preliminary round) and 6 mins (for the final round), as applicable will lead to negative marking.
- No Wi-Fi connectivity will be provided by the organizing school.
- The teams shall not reveal or wear their own identity or the identity of their school such as school uniform, I-card, taking school name while making presentation,etc.
- No character assassination, naming any individual (living or dead) is allowed. The same will lead to disqualification of the team.
- The teams shall speak without overlapping/interrupting other speakers.
- Mutual respect for each other's views shall be appreciated.
- Students should be dressed in formal attire.
- The decision of the panel of experts shall be final and binding in all situations, even though not mentioned otherwise in the list of rules, in the interest of justice.
