1. Definitions

“Company” refers to the EworkUSA platform.

“Merchant” refers to any registered seller or service provider on the platform.

“Customer” refers to users who purchase products or services through the platform.

“Platform” refers to the EworkUSA website and related systems.

“Transaction” refers to any financial activity conducted through the platform.

2. Registration and Eligibility

The Merchant must be at least 18 years old.

The Merchant must provide accurate and valid information during registration.

A valid National ID, Passport, or other legal identification may be required.

The Company reserves the right to verify merchant information at any time.

Providing false information may result in account suspension or termination.

3. Business Conduct

The Merchant must conduct business in compliance with the laws of Bangladesh.

Illegal products or services are strictly prohibited.

Fraudulent activities are strictly forbidden.

Misleading advertising or false promotions are not allowed.

Merchants must maintain professional behavior with customers.

4. Credit Facility

The Company may provide a monthly credit facility up to BDT 500,000 to merchants.

Credit approval is subject to the company's internal policies.

The credit amount must be repaid by the 25th of the same month to the company's bank account.

The Merchant must use the Merchant Code when making deposits to qualify for credit facilities.

Misuse of credit facilities may result in suspension or cancellation.

5. Deposits and Transactions

All deposits must follow the procedures specified by the company.

Merchants must include their Merchant Code during deposits.

The Company is not responsible for deposits made using incorrect codes.

Suspicious transactions may be temporarily held for investigation.

The Company reserves the right to verify and audit transactions.

6. Withdrawal Policy

Merchants may withdraw their balance up to two (2) times per month.

Withdrawal limits may be adjusted based on company policy.

Withdrawals must follow the official withdrawal process.

Delays may occur due to technical or banking issues.

Withdrawals may be temporarily suspended if suspicious activity is detected.

7. Commission Policy

Merchants will receive 4% commission on the withdrawn amount.

No service charge will apply to this commission.

The company reserves the right to modify the commission structure.

Commission will only apply to legitimate and verified transactions.

Fraudulent transactions will result in cancellation of commission.

8. Merchant Responsibilities

Merchants must provide proper services to customers.

Customer complaints must be addressed promptly.

Merchants must participate in monthly operational plans with their customers.

Merchants must follow company policies and guidelines.

Merchants must protect the reputation of the company.
