

Covid Jab in the Philippines

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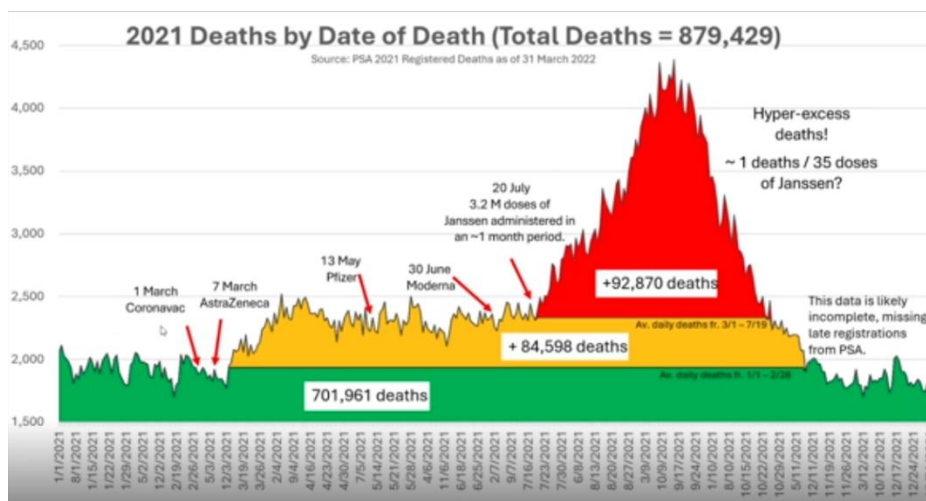
The people of the Philippines were locked down for 3 years. During this time, they were not allowed out of their houses without authorization – a QR code.

In the case of the Philippines, the **first dose was the most lethal**, possibly because the Philippines has a close community, so word spreads fast. So, the damage had to be done quickly, before word could spread.

By far, the most lethal doses were the Janssen batches. 3.2 million doses of Janssen were delivered to the Philippines by **GAVI**. They were delivered to every province of the Philippines, so each province got their own share, and they were all rolled out at exactly the same time, within a period of just a couple of weeks.

Once again, by rolling the jabs out simultaneously, this prevented an alert. Word could not spread. If the Janssen had been rolled out gradually, then some **communities would have been forewarned by the adverse effects in other communities**. It seems that a fast single hit strategy is necessary if a community is strong and integrated.

When they rolled out the Janssen, people were waiting for the Janssen because they were told it was a single dose, so should be safer. But when the Janssen was rolled out, we immediately saw a massive spike in deaths – **1 death per 35 doses of Janssen**.



The Philippines had a pharmacovigilance system, and Janssen received more reports than any other vaccine being used. In the media there were reports – one family of 4 were all given Janssen and the whole family died within days of each other. That report hit the media, and the government said it was Covid – they said it was not due to the vaccine.

There was another story which was briefly reported then disappeared. The government went to the market, lined up all the vendors and made them all take the vaccine. They vaccinated all of the workers in the market – all of the vendors – and all of them died. The market was where people congregated and shared information. By jabbing the market workers then attributing their deaths to Covid, this would have made markets appear as places of “infection”, and **act as a deterrence for meeting to share information**.

In the city of Sibu, Borneo, and across the state of Sarawak, they vaccinated all the prisoners (about 6000 inmates), and in that particular week there was a big spike in “Covid” deaths. They vaccinated from Monday to Wednesday; **the deaths were from Tuesday to Thursday**.

GAVI was negligent in not properly vetting the safety of these Janssen vaccines before pushing them upon the Philippines. We should therefore **be suspicious of any further recommendations or “health” interventions** from such organizations. Government pharmacovigilance systems seem compromised, so a People’s Pharmacovigilance System is needed.
