Conrad Bakker makes carved/painted sculptures and paintings of everyday objects, positioning them in specific sites, consumer contexts, and gallery exhibitions so as to reveal and critically comment upon the socio-political economies and relational networks between persons, things, and places.

Bakker has exhibited his work internationally in venues that include Tate Modern (London), Galerie Analix Forever (Geneva), Fargfabriken Center for Contemporary Art and Architecture (Stockholm), the New Museum of Contemporary Art (New York), the Renaissance Society at the University of Chicago (Chicago), Art in General, Artists' Space, and Apex Art (New York City), Contemporary Art Museum Houston, in mailboxes, eBay auctions, and on his front lawn.
